

213w-14 Aurora Short-sleeved Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Filatura Botto Poala Aspen 4 [100% merino wool; 197 yds/180m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #302 dark brown, 5 skeins [220g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5), 3.9mm (approx. US 6), and 4.2mm (approx. US 7) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.2mm (approx. US 7) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- center back neck-to-cuff 25cm/9.84"
- length 46cm/18.11"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 22 sts and 28.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k3p3 ribbing, then in st st and pattern stitch. Seam 2 shoulder stitches with Kitchener stitch.

Sleeve: Pick up stitches around front and back armholes; increase with backwards loop cast-on. Work 27 rows of k3p3 ribbing with 3.9mm needles, then change to 3.6mm needles and work remaining 12 rows. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam underarm gusset with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline. Work collar in the round in k3p3 ribbing, using 3.9mm needles for rounds 1-10, 4.2mm needles for rounds 11-18, and 3.9mm needles for rounds 19-36. Bind off in pattern. Fold bind-off edge to inside of collar; seam in place with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on


PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even


st st = stockinette stitch

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times



※Alter gauge of sleeve by changing needle size when indicated. Number of stitches remains unchanged.

※Align ☆ and ☆ & ★ and ★ on body and sleeves. Seam together with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch.






Collar: k3p3 ribbing
