

213w-19 Cyrup Purse



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cyrup [52% acrylic, 29% nylon, 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #16 cotton candy, 1 cone [35g]
- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2 [100% superwash wool; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #27 light apricot, 5 skeins [180g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- depth 23cm/9.06"
- mouth of bag (circumference) 62cm/24.41"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 22 sts and 10 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✳️**Note:** entire bag worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Cyrup and 1 strand of Junmo Namibuto2).

Bottom & sides: Ch51 to begin bottom. Work 7 rounds of sc, increasing as indicated in chart. Continue to sides, working 50 rounds back-and-forth in joined rounds. Work 1 round of sc edging followed by 1 round of crab stitch edging.

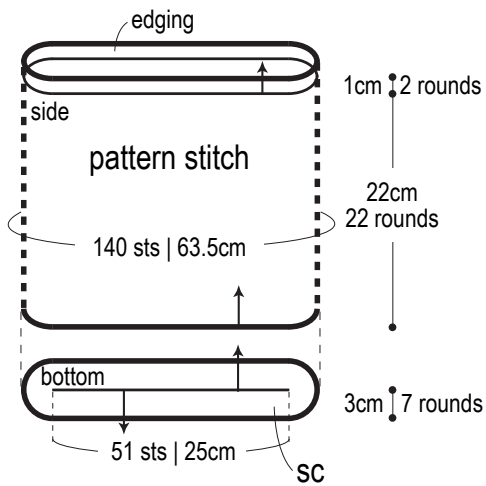
Finishing: Work handles in sc and attach to body of bag. Work cord by starting motif with magic ring, then crocheting a motif, then working a chain. Make a second cord, then sew one to each side of bag.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
m = magic ring
sc = single crochet (US)

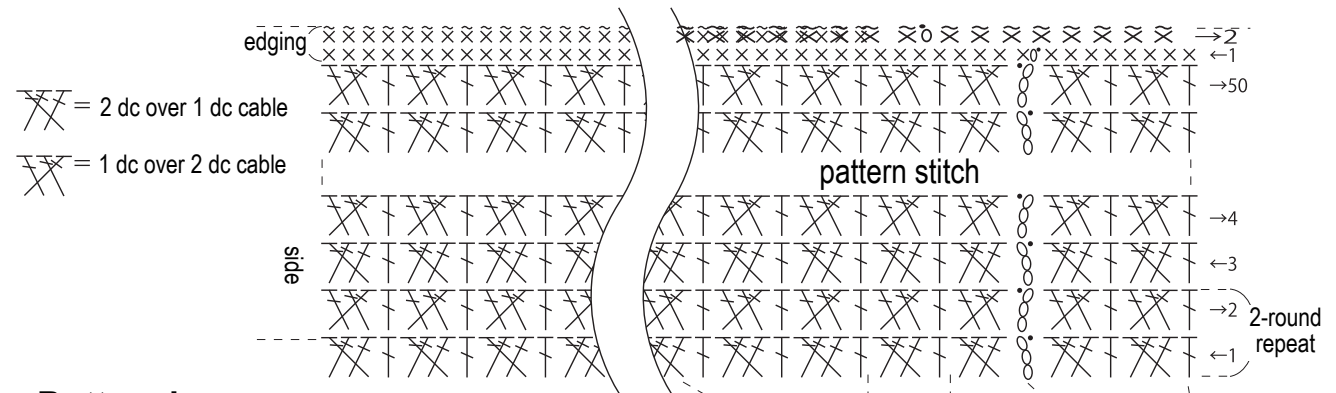
Bag schematic

3.5mm hook

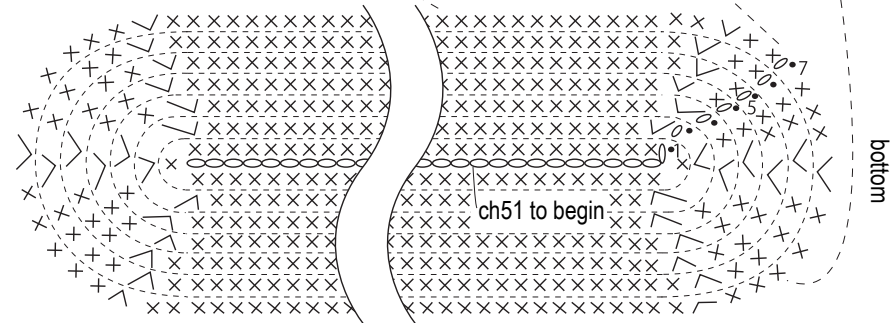


Bottom increases

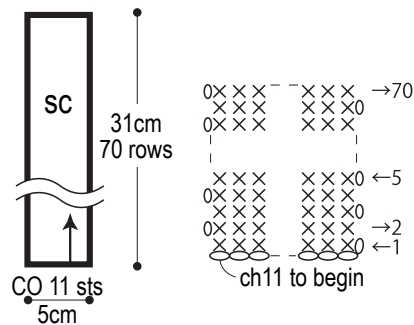

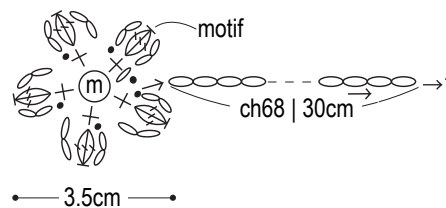
