

213w-20 Colorful Chameleon Socks



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Chameleon Camera [75% superwash wool, 25% nylon; 459 yds/420m per 3.53 oz./100g skein]; color #17 rock, 1 skein [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 2½) double-pointed knitting needles (set of 5) or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- foot length 23cm/9.06"
- cuff circumference: 14cm/5.51"
- cuff length 27cm/10.63"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 29 sts and 38 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in the round from the cuff down. Work 2 rounds of k1p1 ribbing, then continue in k2p2 ribbing. Change needle size when indicated, and decrease 8 stitches while working 1 round of stockinette stitch. Referring to chart, knit heel and lower foot in stockinette stitch. When finished, graft toe with Kitchener stitch.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

dec = decrease


k2tog = knit 2 stitches together knitwise

RE = round(s) even

ssk = slip, slip, knit


#-# = rounds-stitches-times (for example, 2-1-4 means "every 2 rounds, decrease/increase 1 stitch; do this 4 times")

Socks




Kitchener stitch instructions


① Insert needle into 1 st at edge.




② Insert needle where marked in step ①.



③ Insert needle through edge st and st next to it.




④ Repeat steps ② and ③.



*Align stitches of knitted fabric. Graft together by linking each stitch to the ones below it, forming a row of knit stitches as you go.
