213w-27 Jewel Mitts







Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Jewel [55% polyester, 45% wool; 109 yds/100m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - · ladies' mitts: color #05 glossy gray, 2 skeins [45g]
 - girls' mittens: color #02 powdery rose, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) and 5.1mm (approx. US 8) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 10 pearl beads (5mm/0.20" diameter) per pair of mitts/mittens

Finished measurements:

- ladies' size: palm circumference 21cm/8.27"
- girls' size: palm circumference 16cm/6.30"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 17 sts and 22 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 19 sts and 26 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Ladies' fingerless mitts: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch in the round. On palm, work thumb stitches with waste yarn. Change to k1p1 ribbing again and them bind off in pattern. Pick up stitches from waste yarn; work thumb in stockinette stitch in the round. Bind off.

Girls' mittens: Begin as for ladies' mitts. Work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch in the round. Work thumb stitches with waste yarn as for ladies' mitts. Starting from round 22, work 4 evenly spaced 1-st decreases spread across each round three times. Seam remaining stitches from palm and back of hand using Kitchener stitch. Work thumb as for ladies' mitt, but on the final round, work decreases using ssk. Thread yarn tail through remaining stitches and cinch tip of thumb shut.

Finishing: Make 2 ribbons (per pair) and attach to back of hand. Fasten pearl beads to ribbons, referring to schematic for placement.




BO = bind off CO = cast on OH = place on hold (that is, place on stitch holder) PU = pick up


ssk = slip 1 st knitwise, slip another st knitwise, knit these two sts together through back #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

Ladies' mitt: thumb











*Fasten ribbon & beads to both right and left hands.






Using waste yarn



① On palm side, knit thumb sts with waste yarn rather than main yarn.




2 Return the 4 sts knit with waste yarn to left needle. Knit across with main yarn.




3 Continue on with knitting.
