

213w-3 Flare-sleeve Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Fingering [100% merino wool; 183 yds/167m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #11 sea green, 11 skeins [410g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 95cm/37.40"
- cross back width 39.5cm/15.55"
- back length 60cm/23.62"
- sleeve length 43cm/16.93"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 30 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Back & front body: Work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch, decreasing as indicated.

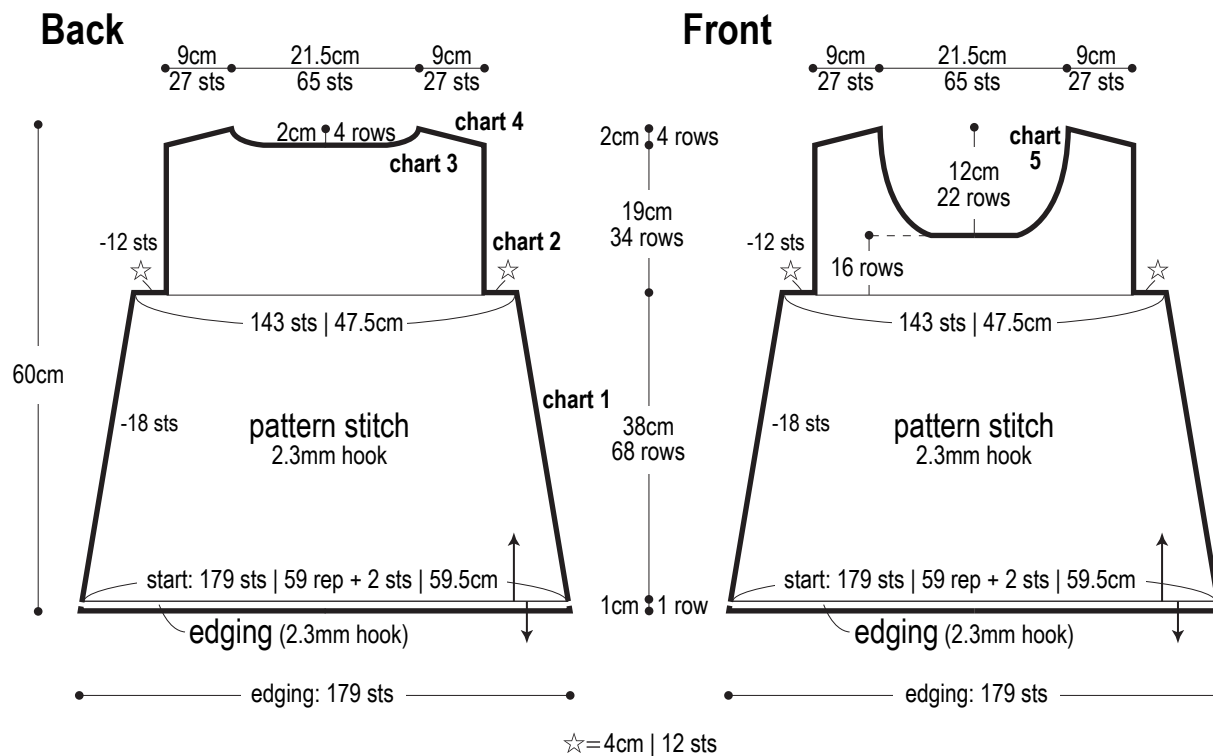
Sleeve: Work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch, decreasing as indicated.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with whipstitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Work edging in the round around neckline, hem, and cuffs. Seam sleeves to body with chain seam. *Note: The width of the sleeve cap is somewhat wider than the armhole where you will attach it, so you may need to ease the fabric into place.

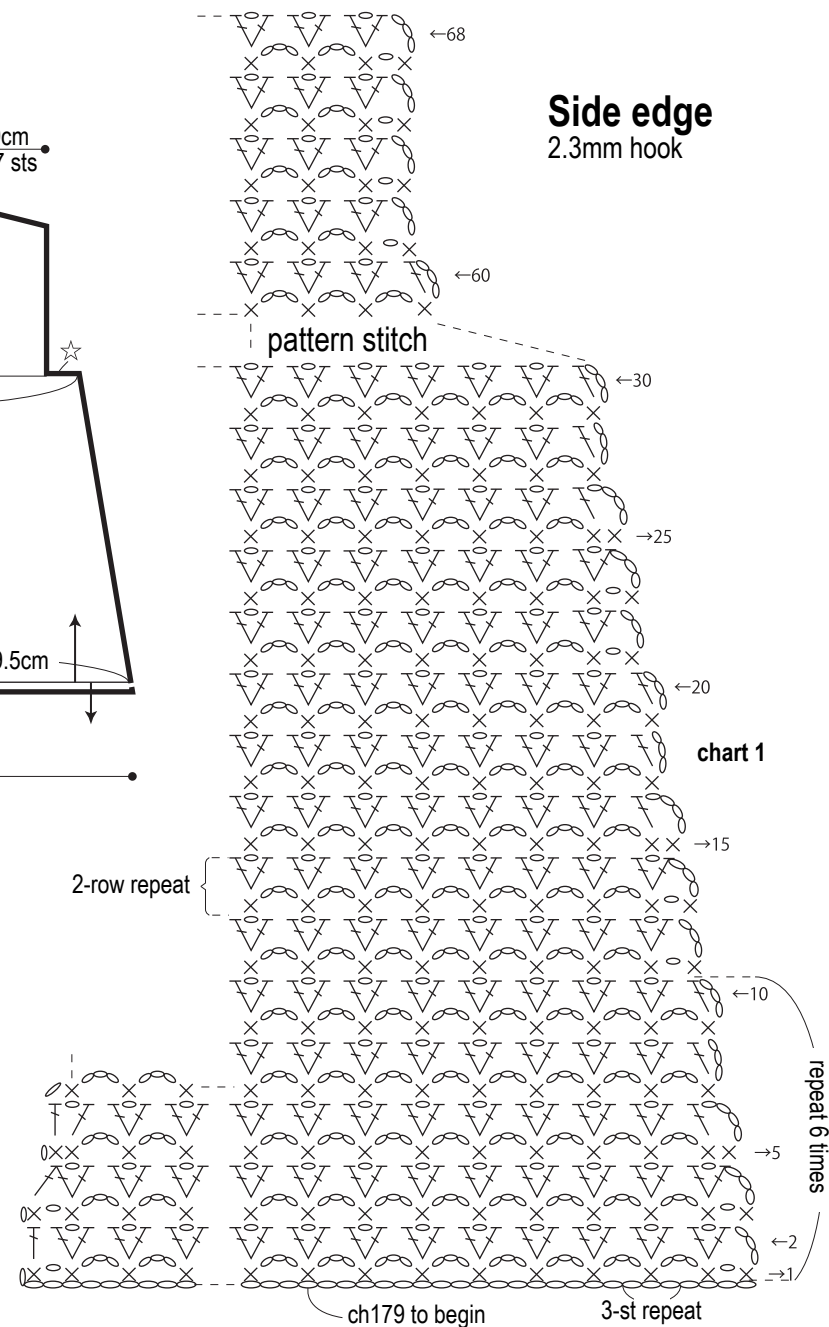
Abbreviations:

rep = pattern repeat(s)

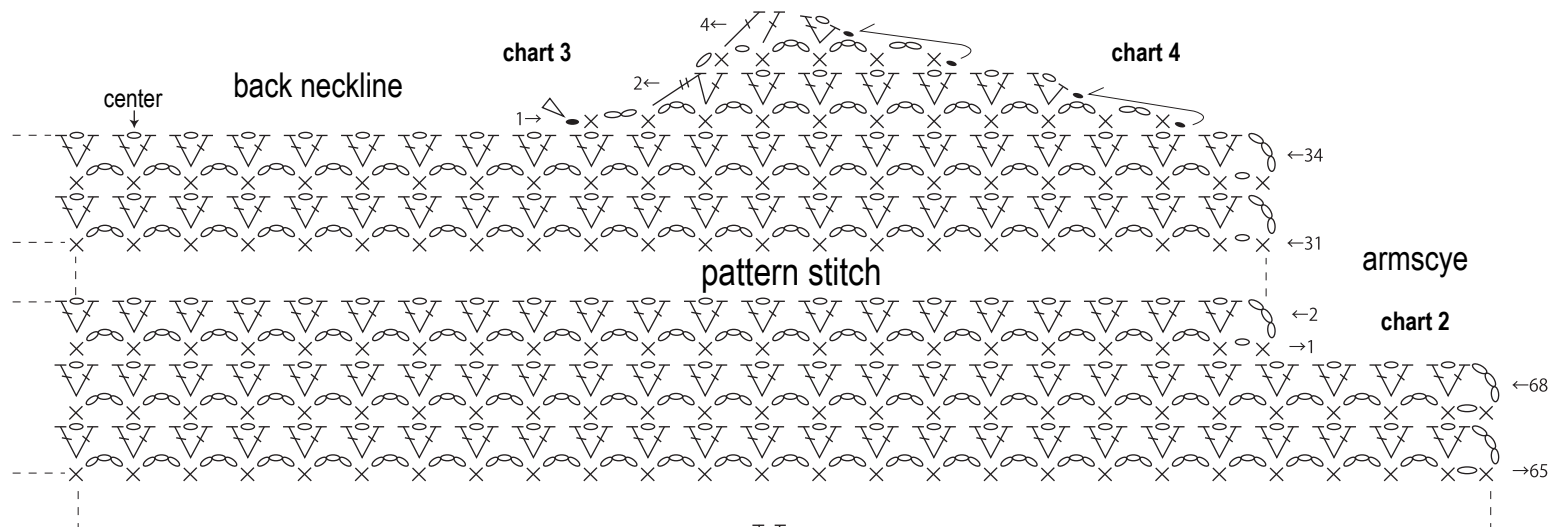

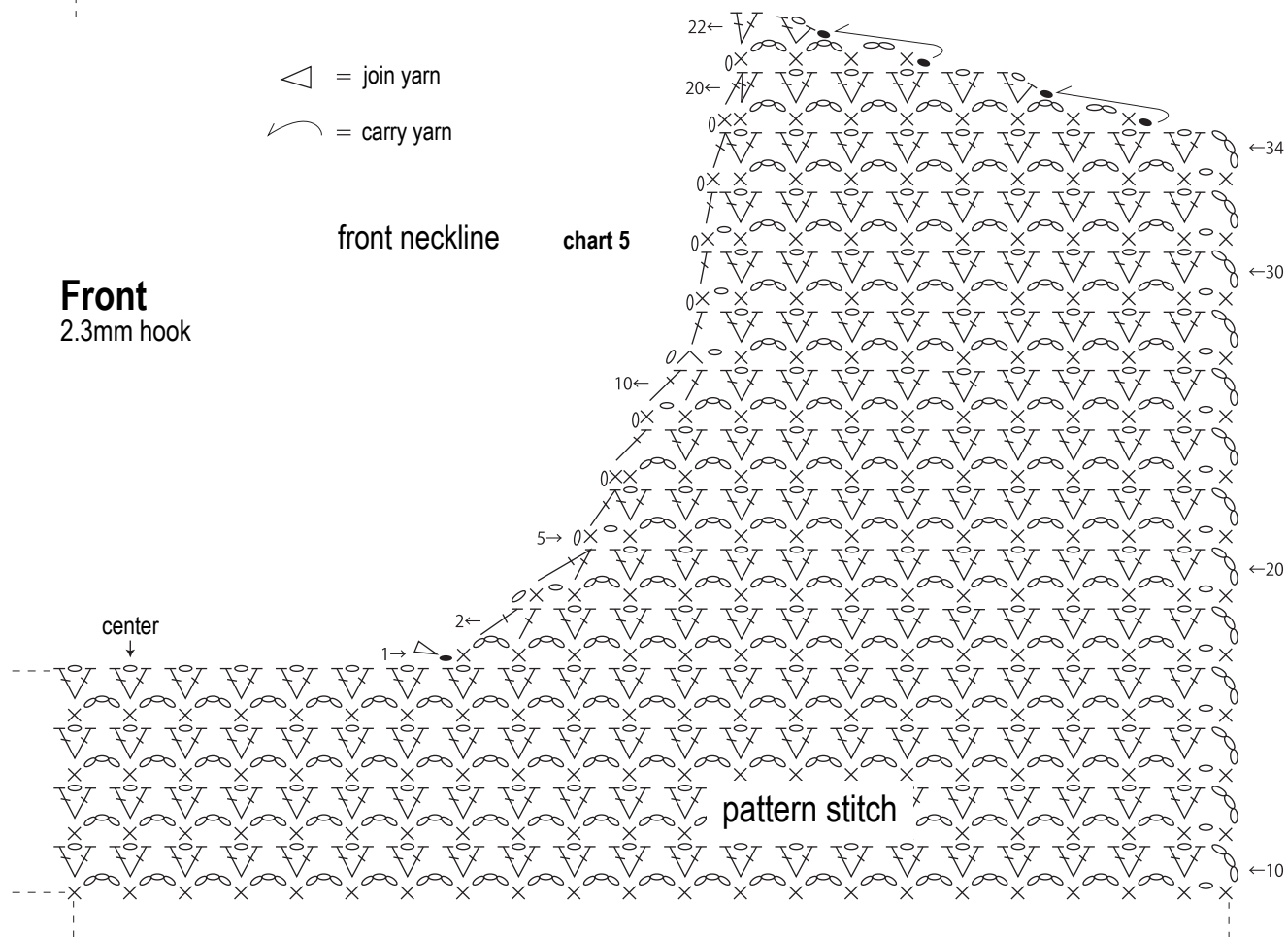
2.3mm hook

 ↪ = carry yarn

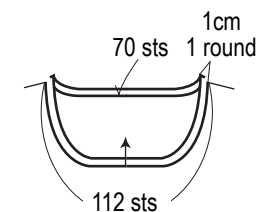
Front

2.3mm hook



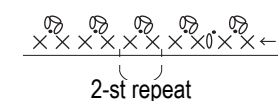
Finishing

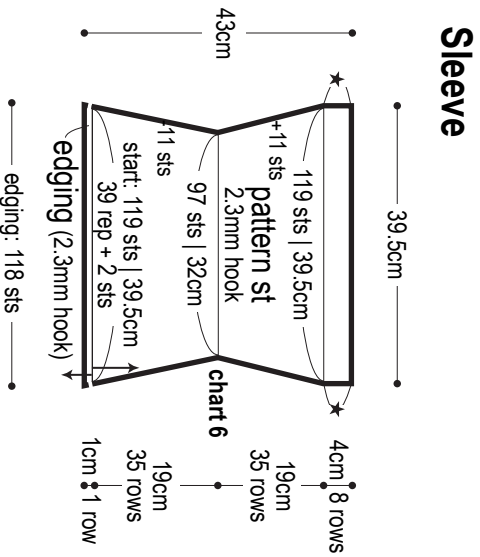
Edging
