

213fw-30 Nordic Coat with Fur Trim



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nordic [100% wool; 131 yds/120m per 2.82 oz./80g skein];
 - girls' size: color #01 ivory, 5 skeins [345g]
 - ladies' size: color #02 greige, 7 skeins [560g]
- Pierrot Yarns Savon [100% nylon; 61 yds/56m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - girls' size: color #04 old rose, 2 skeins [50g]
 - ladies' size: color #02 nude beige, 3 skeins [100g]

- Pierrot Yarns Foire 4-ply [100% wool; 178 yds/163m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - girls' size: color #56 honey cream, 1 skein [10g]
 - ladies' size: color #56 honey cream, 1 skein [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) and 5.7mm (approx. US 9) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge - also double-pointed needles in largest size
- cable needle
- * 5 buttons per coat (20mm/0.79")

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

| • pattern stitch A (with 5.1mm needles): 14 sts and 23 rows | • stockinette stitch A (with 5.7mm needles): 14 sts and 18 rows |
| • pattern stitch B (with 5.7mm needles): 15 sts and 19 rows | • reverse stockinette stitch B (with 5.7mm needles): 12 sts and 16.5 rows |

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

✳️**Note:** Stockinette stitch B sections are worked with 3 strands of yarn held together: 2 strands of Savon and 1 strand of Foire 4-ply.

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitches A and B. For front only, work buttonbands in pattern stitch C at the same time, working buttonholes in right front band only. Reverse shaping of right front for left front, noting that the pattern stitches remain the same.

Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch A. Seam sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around cast-on edge; work reverse stockinette stitch B in the round. Bind off with purl stitches.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Seam ends of back collar pieces (right and left) using crochet slip stitch seam. Seam back collar to body with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Join sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Fasten buttons.

Collar: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch B, increasing with backwards loop cast-on at both edges. Referring to schematics, whipstitch collar to body.

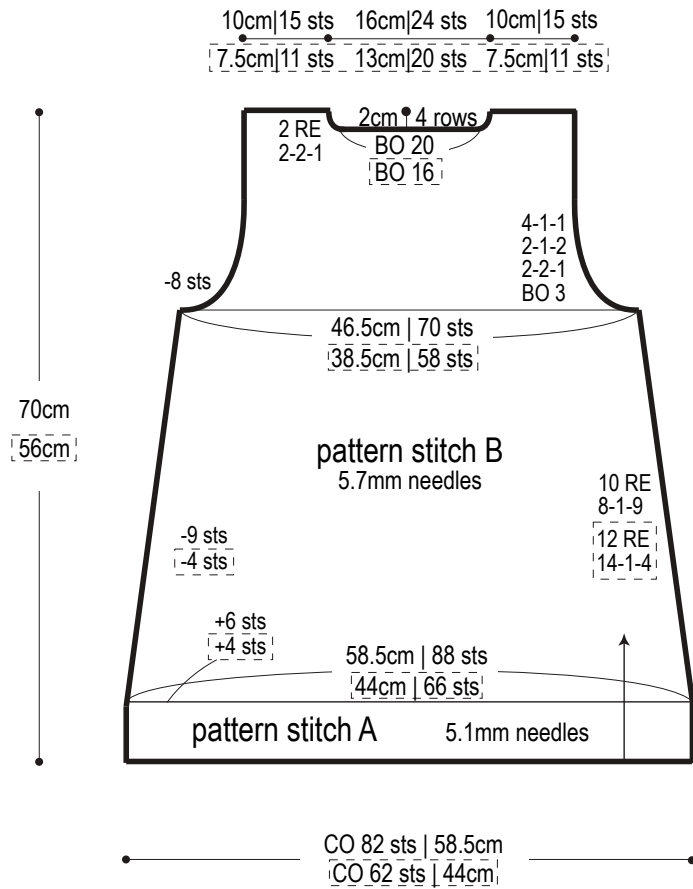

BO = bind off CO = cast on RE = row(s) even RS = right side WS = wrong side #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

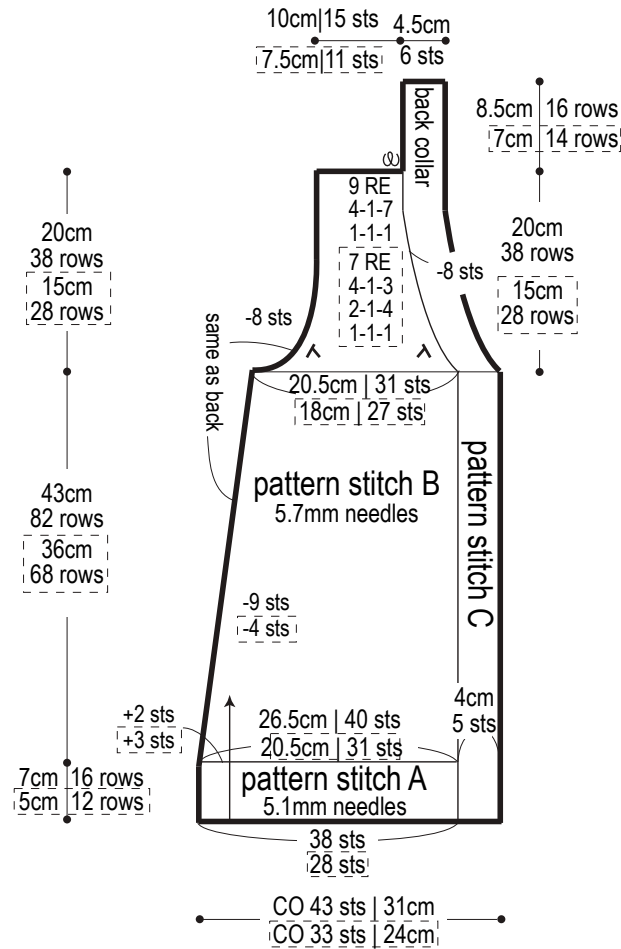

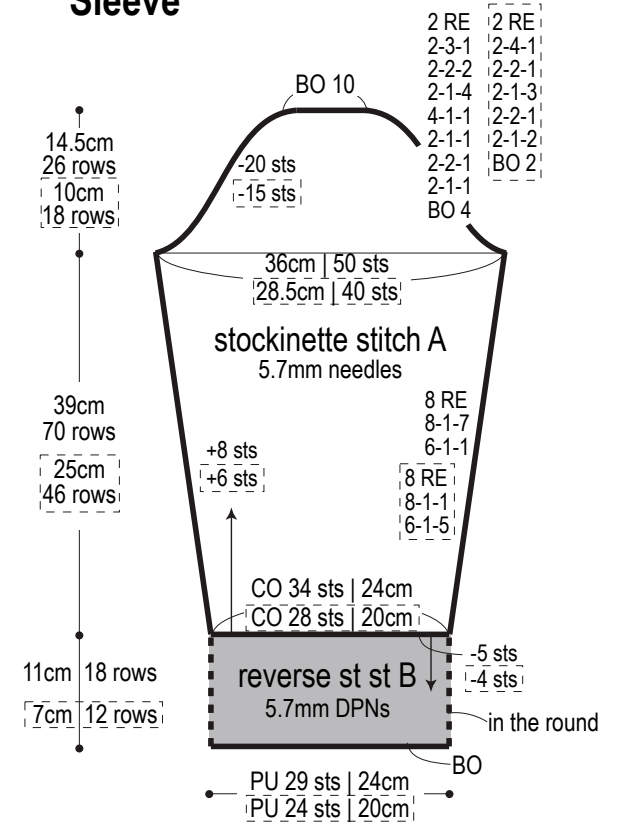


Right front



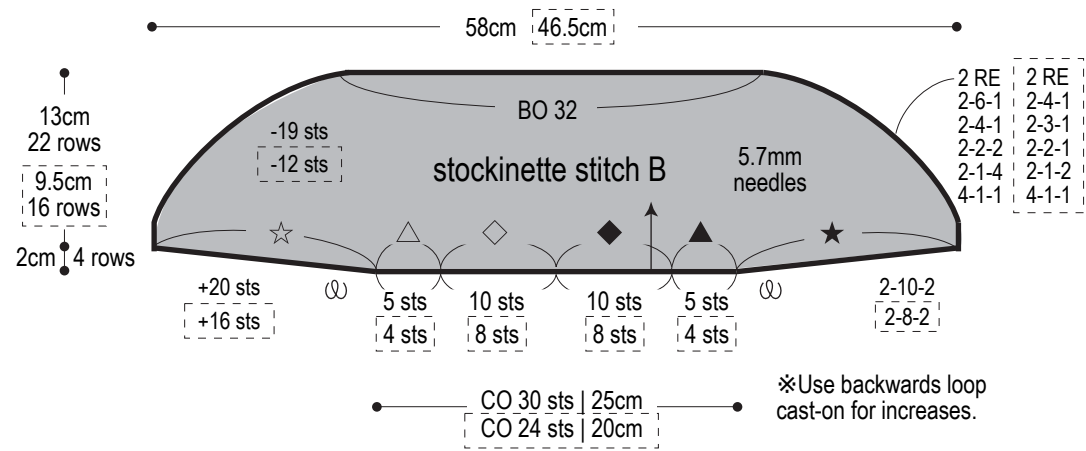
*Reverse shaping of right front for left front, leaving stitch patterns unchanged.

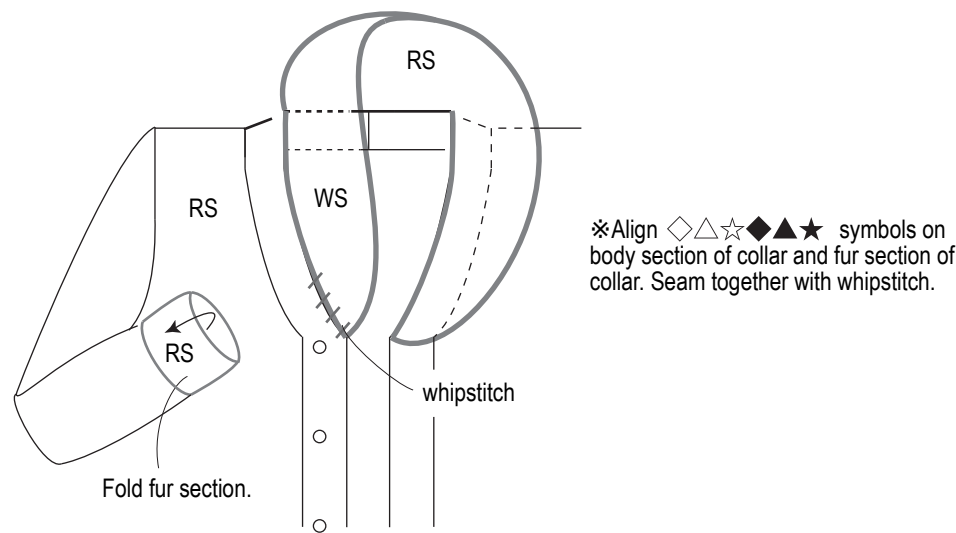


■ = 3 strands of yarn held together: 2 strands of Savon & 1 strand of Foire 4-ply

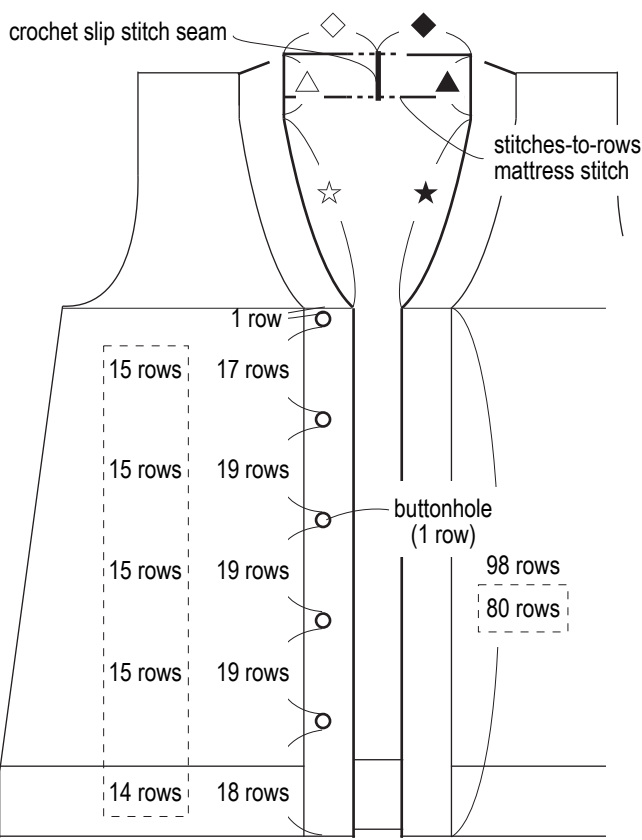

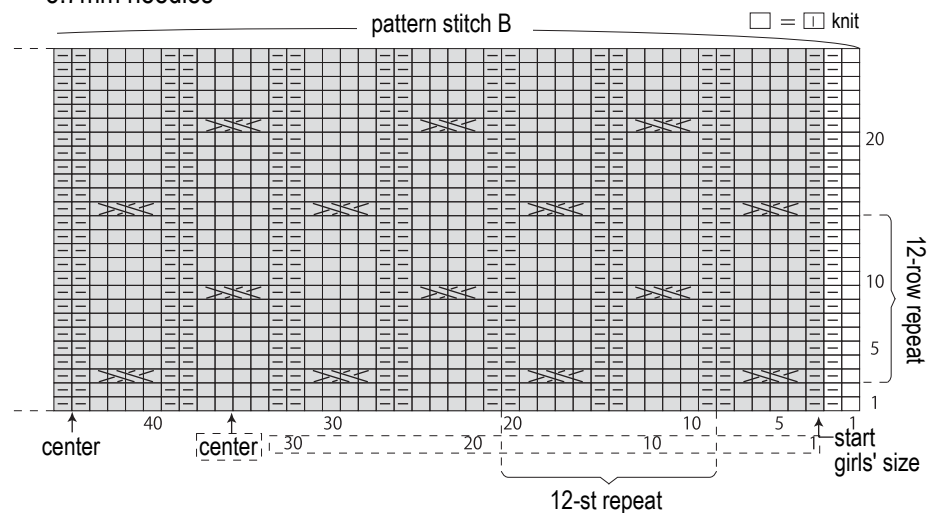

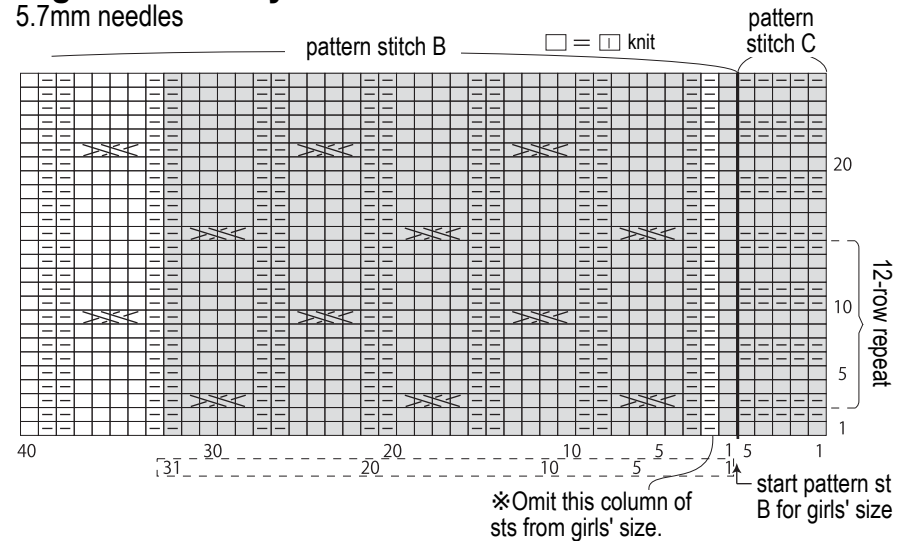
Back body

5.7mm needles



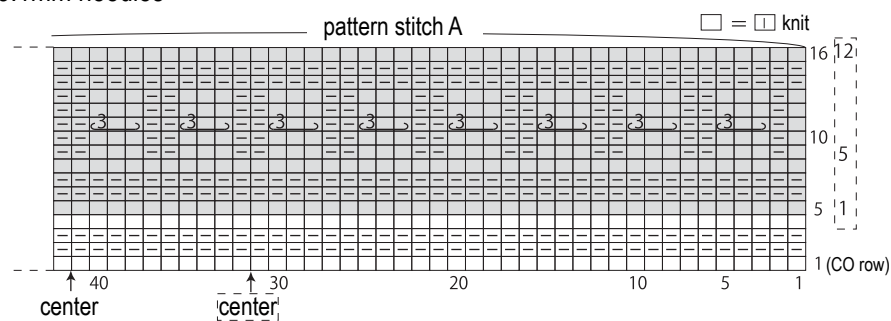
Right front body

5.7mm needles



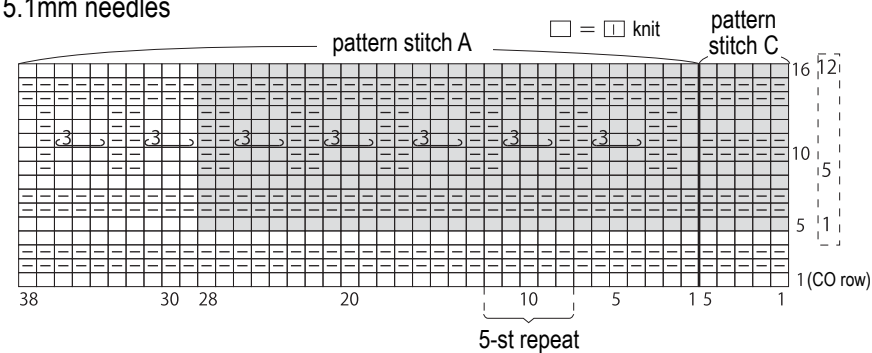
Back hem

5.1mm needles

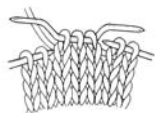


Right front hem

Wrap yarn around these 3 sts 3 times counterclockwise.



Completed 3-wrap stitch.
