

213w-1 Pochette Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pochette [50% superwash merino wool; 50% cotton; 131 yds/120m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #12 platinum gray, 9 skeins [345g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C), 3.0mm (approx. US C or D), and 3.5mm (US E) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 buttons (15mm/0.59" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- bust 93.5cm/36.81"
- cross back width 34.5cm/13.58"
- back length 65.5cm/25.79"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A (with 2.5mm hook): 29 sts and 16 rows
- pattern stitch B: 28.5 sts and 13 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Body: Work foundation chain to begin back. Work skirt section in pattern stitch A, altering gauge as shown (by changing hook size). Working into foundation chain, work bodice section in pattern stitch B. Work front piece in the same manner as the back piece.


Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides with chain seam. Work edging A around hem. Working edging B continuously along front edges and neckline, working buttonholes in right front as you go. Work edging B in the round along armholes. Attach buttons to left front buttonband.

Abbreviations:


ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)



Right front




Edging B





Edging A
