213w-4 Aspen V-neck Sweater



Suggested yarn:

• Filatura Botto Poala Aspen 3 [100% cashmere; 126 yds/115m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #18 white, 12 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- back length 62cm/24.41"
- sleeve length 55cm/21.65"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 24 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Change needle size, then continue in pattern stitch. Shape armscye and neckline by binding off stitches where indicated and by working decreases at edges. Shape shoulders with short rows. Shape sleeve edges by working fully fashioned increases (1 st in from edge) with lifted increases.

Finishing: Join shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Join sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.



CO = cast on


PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even








Collar k1p1 ribbing, 3.3mm DPNs
