

29-14 Tee with Granny Square Trim



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Platnum Kirakira Cotton [51% acrylic, 49% cotton; 85 yds/78m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #61 white, 3 skeins [270g]
 - color #67 light silver, 2 skeins [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 54cm/21.26"
- length 58.5cm/23.03"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 27 rows
- each motif should be 6cm/2.36" square

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips


Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Shape waist using decreases at edges (k2tog or ssk) and lifted increases at edges. Place marker at beginning of armhole opening. Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Crochet motifs, joining to each other and to hem/neckline as you go.

Finishing: Work edging in the round along hem, armholes, and neckline.








Collar: edging B


2.5mm hook



※ For edgings A and B, use color #67 light silver.




Edging A




Motif chart
