

# 213fw-13 Ribbon Scrunchie



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% extra fine merino; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #203 deep blue, 1 skein [20g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 elastic hair band

## Finished measurements:

- Please see schematic.

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 22 sts and 30 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Body of scrunchie & ribbon:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch. Bind off.

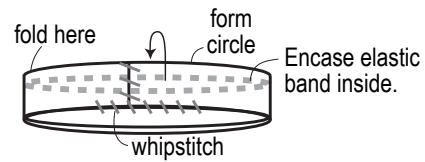
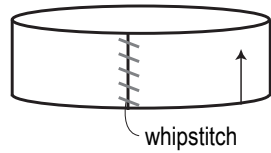
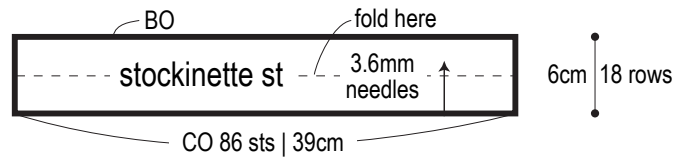
**Finishing:** Align sides of body piece with right side facing you; seam together with whipstitch. Fold at line indicated, insert elastic band, and seam cast-on edge to bind-off edge with whipstitch. Seam ends of ribbon part A together with whipstitch. Wrap yarn around center of part A, forming gathers at center. Wrap part B around the area wrapped in yarn; seam part B in place with whipstitch. Seam ribbon to body of scrunchie.

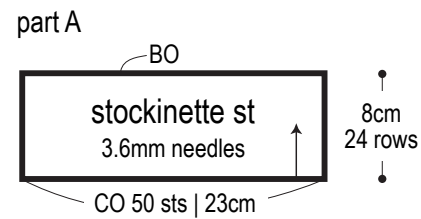
BO = bind off

CO = cast on

## Body of scrunchie

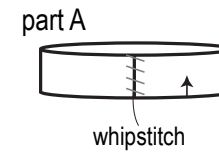


## Ribbon

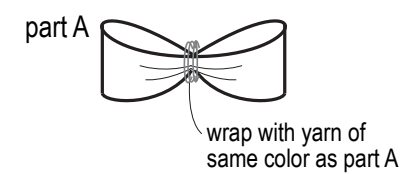


## Finishing

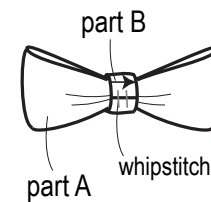
① Form into a loop; whipstitch ends together.



② Wrap yarn around center; tie securely.



③ Wrap part B around center section wrapped in yarn. Whipstitch in place.



④ Seam ribbon to body of scrunchie, such that seam on part B of ribbon connects to body of scrunchie.
