

23-24-21 Cabled Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Alpaca [80% alpaca, 20% lambswool; 241 yds/220m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #5 gray, 5 skeins [200g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- 4 buttons (20mm/0.79")

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 39cm/15.35"
- back length 56cm/22.05"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 26 rows
- pattern stitch A: 210 sts and 26 rows
- pattern stitch B: 27 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

✳️**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Pocket: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work according to schematic. Bind off 1 st at front edge; put the rest of the stitches on a stitch holder. Pick up stitches along mouth of pocket; work edging in k1p1 ribbing.

Back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. After last row, place stitches on stitch holder. Pick up stitches around armhole; work edging in k1p1 ribbing. Pick up stitches for yoke from back body; work front & back yoke in one continuous piece according to schematic. Bind off with 1x1 tubular bind-off method.

Front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work until top of pocket, placing markers for pocket where indicated on schematic. Align pocket stitches on stitch holder with body stitches; knit them together as one row. On last row of front body, bind off all stitches. Seam pocket to body with mattress stitch where indicated.

Finishing: Fold front yoke down to front body; seam to start of yoke ribbing. Seam sides with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

dec = decrease

k = knit

OH = on hold (place on stitch holder)


p = purl

PU = pick up


RE = row(s) even
