

# 98-99-12 Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso (Pure Wool Finger) [50% merino wool, 50% other wool; 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #323 black, 5 skeins [200g]
- Pierrot Yarns Justy [60% polyester, 40% rayon; 984 yds/900m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #6402 gold lamé, 1 cone [95g]

## Tools/Notions:

- standard-gauge knitting machine (4.5mm pitch) with punchcard capability *or* knitting needles necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- cross back width 38cm/14.96"
- back length 57cm/22.44"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.87"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 31 sts and 36 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Body:** Cast on with waste yarn. Work 31 rows in pattern stitch B. Hang stitches from cast-on edge back on the needles; knit together with current row to form hem. Beginning working pattern stitch A from punchcard where marked. Seam shoulders by hanging stitches of one shoulder with right side facing you. Seam shoulders as follows: hang one shoulder on needle with right side facing you, then push all stitches behind latches. Hang the corresponding piece on same needles with wrong side facing you, but do not push these stitches behind latches. Push needle butts back so that stitches in hooks pull through stitches behind latches. Knit 1 row, then work sewn bind-off.

**Sleeve:** Work cast-on and hem as for body. After completing hem, work sleeve in pattern stitch A, starting from row 1 of punchcard.


**Finishing:** For stockinette portion of folded hem and cuffs, reduce setting on tension dial; work first 2 rows after cast-on and last two rows before bind-off in lamé yarn. For the collar, use lamé yarn only for tip of fold.

## Abbreviations:


T = tension dial setting



**Front**





**Collar: gauge changes**



1 repeat = 24 sts and 70 rows





※Because the first 2 rows worked in gold lamé continue from the 2 gold lamé rows of the hem, they have been omitted from the punchcard shown above.
