

21-3 Silk Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk100 Sport [100% silk; 169 yds/155m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #9111 light frosty gray, 8 cones [360g]
- Pierrot Yarns Kirara [89% acetate, 11% polyester; 1892 yds/1730m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #4802 light pink & silver lamé, 1 cone [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 2½) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 55cm/21.65"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 27 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

✳️**Note:** Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Silk100 Sport and 1 strand of Kirara).

Body: Crochet foundation chain (with same yarn as body) and work 1 row of sc. Change to knitting needles, picking up stitches from sc row (see tutorial). Work in pattern stitch.

Sleeve: Begin as for body. Work 1 pattern repeat at the center of each sleeve.

Collar: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Pick up stitches around neckline and work collar in garter stitch in the round. Bind off from wrong side.

Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

✳️As silk can lose its shape, it's important to have a firm gauge. If your gauge is too loose, please choose smaller needles.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

sc = single crochet (US)

WS = wrong side

= rows-stitches-times

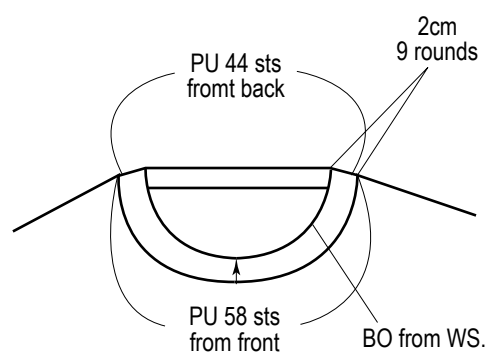

- Overall height: 55cm.

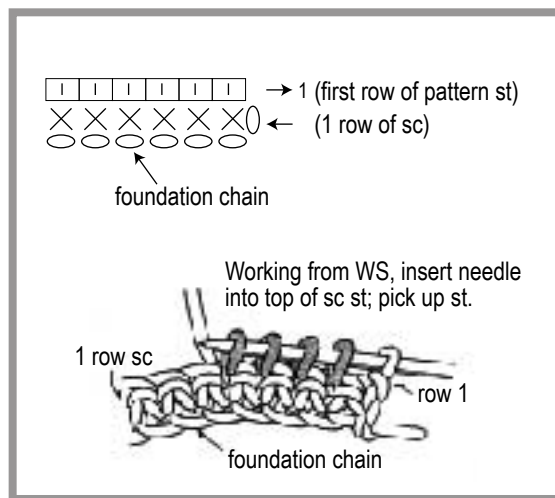

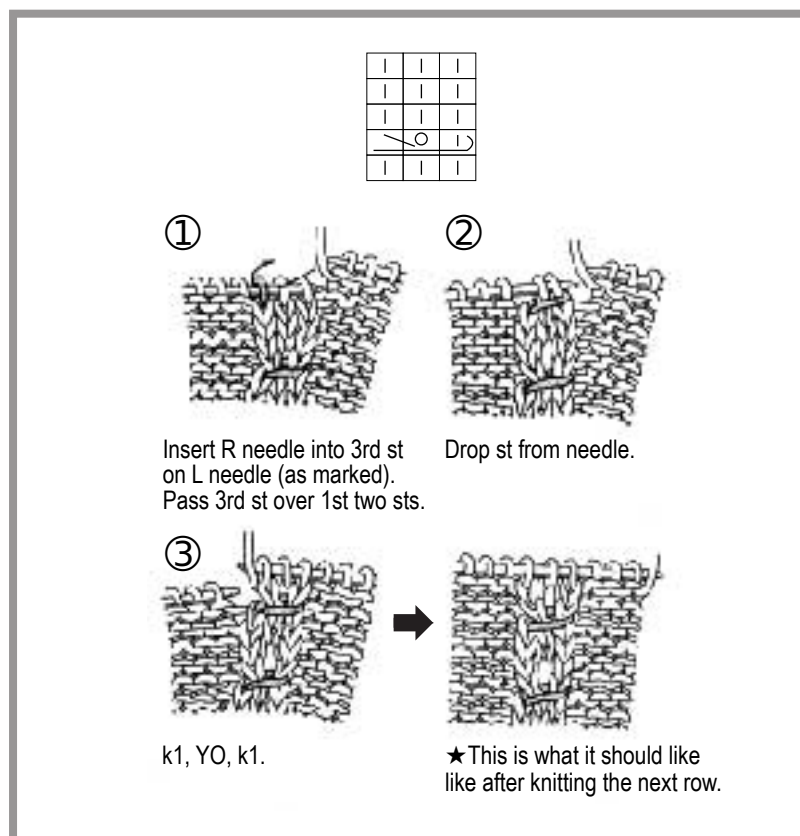

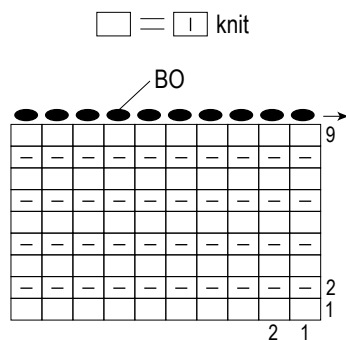
