

# 213w-21 Two-color Bubble Sweater



## Suggested yarn:

- Grignasco Bubble [68% wool, 32% acrylic; 24 yds/22m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
  - color #1357 neve, 7 skeins [350g]
  - color #1364 notte, 8 skeins [385g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 12.0mm (approx. US 17) and 15.0mm (US 19) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 12.0mm (approx. US 17) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 104cm/40.94"
- cross back width 42cm/16.54"
- back length 67cm/26.38"
- sleeve length 59cm/23.23"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 6 sts and 6 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Back & front body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Change needle size and continue in stockinette stitch. Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam.

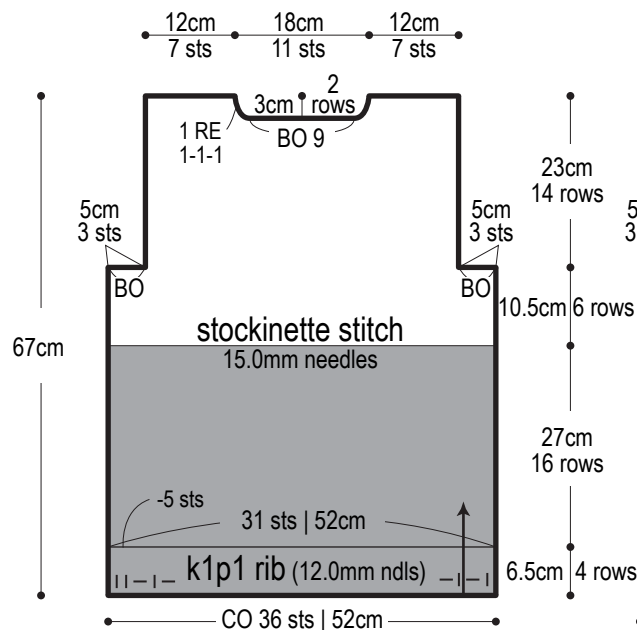
**Sleeves:** Pick up stitches from armscye of front and back body. Work sleeve in stockinette stitch and then in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

**Finishing:** Seam underarm gusset to body with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sides of body and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. (Because the yarn is thick, it is suggested that you seam through only one loop of a stitch rather than the bar between stitches.) Pick up stitches around neckline. Work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

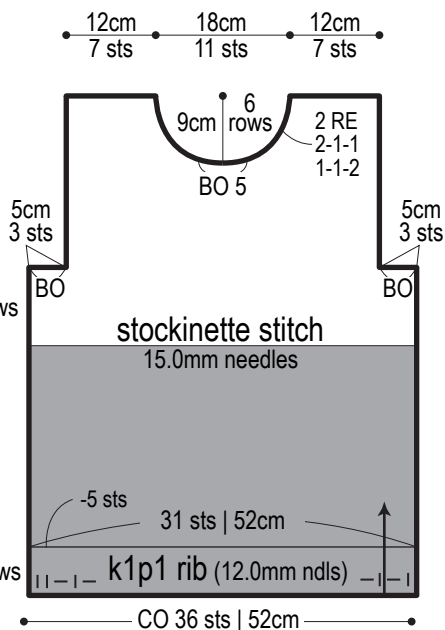

BO = bind off      CO = cast on      PU = pick up      RE = row(s) even      ### = rows-stitches-times

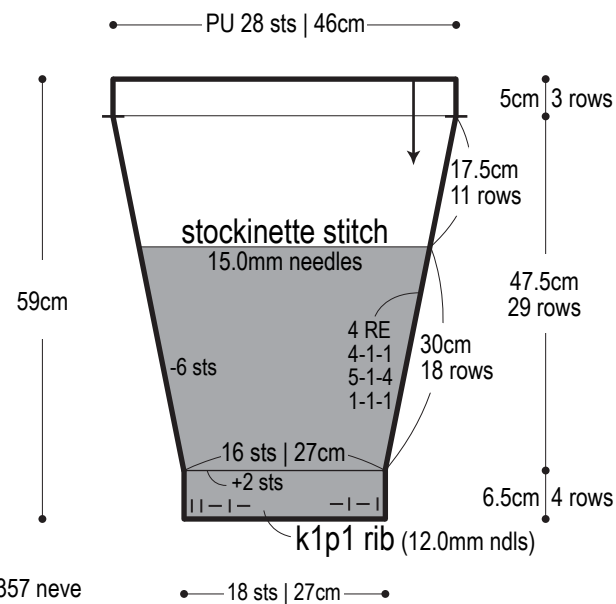
## Back



## Front

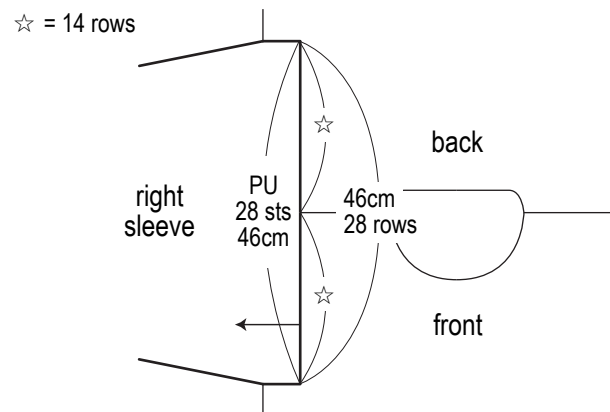


## Sleeve

 ■ = #1364 notte

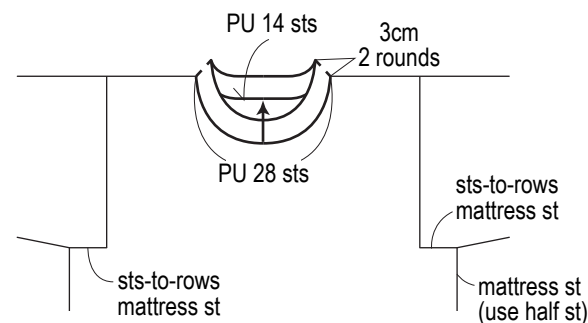
## Picking up stitches for sleeve

k1p1 ribbing, 12.0mm DPNs

※Alternatively, use a 12.0mm circular needle.



※For neater side & sleeve seams, we suggest using a smooth DK, worsted or bulky yarn for seaming.
