

28-23 Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Platinum Kirakira Cotton [51% acrylic, 49% cotton; 85 yds/78m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #65 saxe, 7 skeins [270g] – discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4 buttons (20mm/0.79")

Finished measurements:

- bust 94.5cm/37.20"
- cross back width 34.5cm/13.58"
- length 56.5cm/22.24"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 19 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips


Body: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch according to schematic. Shape armhole and neckline by binding off stitches as indicated and by working decreases at the edges.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around armhole and work twisted k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off, then work 1 round of crab stitch. Remove provisional cast-on edge at hem, picking up live stitches. Work edging as for neckline (but in rows rather than rounds). Pick up stitches along front edges and neckline; work collar & buttonband in same pattern as armhole edging. Be sure to work buttonholes in right front edge only.

Abbreviations:


- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- k = knit
- p = purl
- PU = pick up
- RE = row(s) even
- #/# = rows-stitches-times




☆ = 3.6mm needles


Neckline, buttonband, and armhole edging



Twisted k1p1 ribbing & buttonholes


3.3mm needles

*Work buttonholes at right front only.




Pattern stitch A
