MeriSilk Overskirt



Suggested yarn:

 Grignasco MeriSilk [80% merino wool, 20% silk; 273 yds/250m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #3 retro modern, 4 skeins [160g]

Tools/Notions:

• 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- · width 108cm/42.52"
- length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 7 chain spaces and 16.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.


Crochet Tips

Body of skirt: Work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch. Cut yarn, then join yarn and work edgings A and B in the round.

Finishing: With 2 strands of yarn held together, crochet a motif starting with magic ring. After finishing motif, continue cord by working a chain. Thread cord through first round of skirt edging, then crochet another motif on the opposite end of the cord.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain ch sp = chain space(s) m = magic ring rep = pattern repeat(s)




Finishing

Thread cord through here. 50cm

3.5mm hook, 2 strands of yarn



*Work the motif for the opposite end of the cord separately. Then, after threading cord through skirt edging, seam motif to end.
