

# 214ss-06 Dolman Sweater



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [100% cotton; 416 yds/380m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #1 white, 3 cones [270g]
- Pierrot Yarns CyruP [52% acrylic, 29% nylon, 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #16 cotton candy, 3 cones [105g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge (for provisional cast-on only)
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- center back neck-to-cuff 52.5cm/20.67"
- back length 59cm/23.23"

## Gauge:

- pattern stitch A: 11 sts = 4.5cm/1.77" and 35 rows = 10cm/4"
- pattern stitch B: 8 sts = 4cm/1.57" and 35 rows = 10cm/4"
- pattern stitch C: 10 sts = 3cm/1.18" and 35 rows = 10cm/4"
- k1p1 ribbing: 26 sts and 40 rows = 10cm/4" square

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

※Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Sawayaka Cotton and 1 strand of CyruP).


**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Begin working sideways in pattern stitch starting from cuff area. ??? Pick up 50 sts from crochet chain worked in advance for this purpose. Pick up stitches from hem; work welt in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Knit another piece identical to the first.

**Finishing:** Seam from cuff area to marker for neck opening with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around each cuff edge. Work cuff in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with crochet slip stitch seam, but seam hem and cuff ribbing sections with mattress stitch.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off      CO = cast on      PU = pick up      RE = row(s) even      # #-# = rows-stitches-times


## Body (make 2)




※For first sleeve (on the cast-on side of the pullover), use backwards loop cast-on for increases.


※To pick up 50 sts for side, first work a crochet chain 50 sts long. Pick up and knit from this chain.
