

214ss-08 French-sleeve Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns New Fresco Lino Fine [100% linen; 164 yds/150m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #108 antique rose, 3 skeins [95g]
- Pierrot Yarns New Fresco Lino Grande [100% linen; 131 yds/120m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #209 garnet, 3 skeins [170g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 30.5cm/12.01"
- back length 46cm/18.11"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 11 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Back body: Work foundation chain to begin. Work even in pattern stitch (no shaping), changing yarn color every 6 rows. Place markers for neckline opening.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain stitch and slip stitch as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides up until markers for armholes using chain seam. Work 3 rounds of edging along neckline, armholes, and hem, respectively.



ch = chain


pm = place marker





Pattern stitch

2.5mm hook




Collar & armhole edging
