

214ss-15 Elmer Shrug



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Elmer [80% wool, 20% silk; 175 yds/160m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #01 powder beige, 4 skeins [145g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 57.5cm/22.64"
- back length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 25 sts and 12.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body: Work foundation chain of 243 sts to begin. Referring to chart and schematic, work 61 rows even and then edging. Work edging on the other long edge by working into foundation chain.

Finishing: Pick stitches at each short end. Work cuff at each end in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Seam each cuff section with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

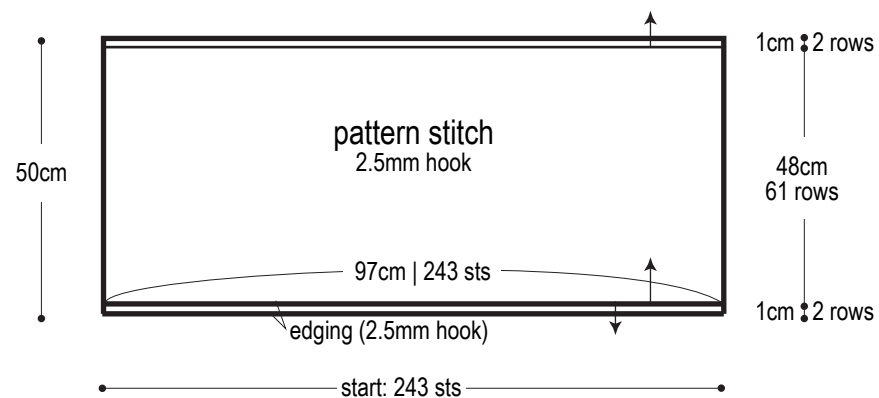
k = knit

p = purl

RS = right side

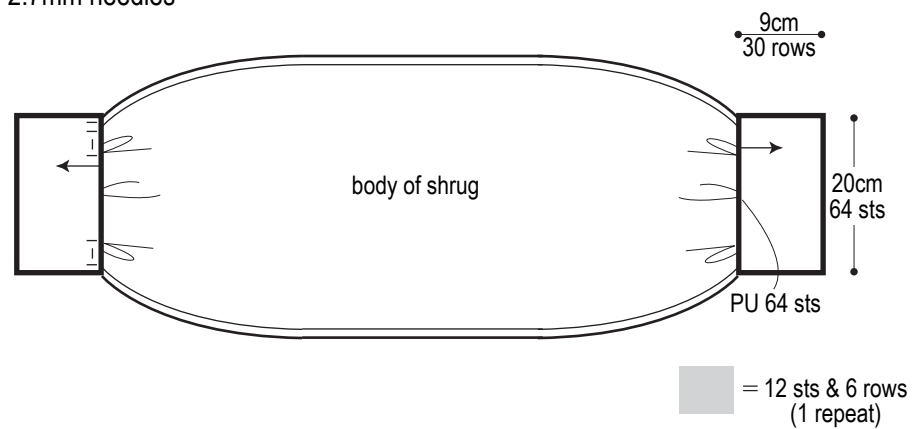
WS = wrong side

Body of shrug

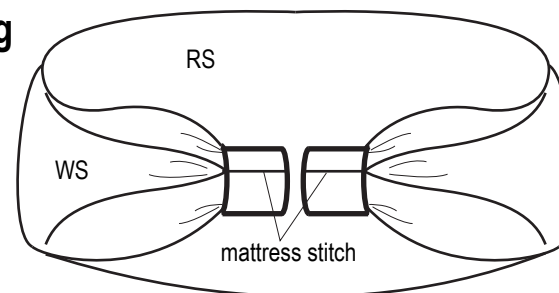


Cuffs: k1p1 ribbing
