

214ss-17 Marché Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns New Fresco Lino Grande [100% linen; 131 yds/120m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #214 shadow blue, 6 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 pair bamboo purse handles

Finished measurements:

- width 37cm/14.57"
- length (excluding handles) 25cm/9.84"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 18.5 sts and 11 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✿**Note:** entire bag worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Bottom: ch45 to begin. Work in sc, increasing at both ends (to form an oval shape).

Sides: ch136 to begin, then work 25 rows in pattern stitch. Work 6 rows in sc. Seam ends together with whipstitch to form a loop.

Finishing: Align edges of bottom and sides; seam together by working sc through both layers. Crochet 6 belt pieces, insert handles, then seam handles in place by seaming belt pieces to bag on wrong side.

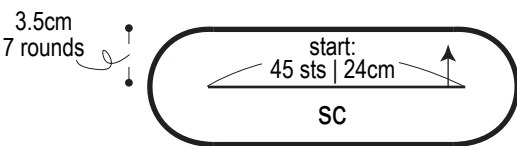

※Once per end of oval, sc2tog on side while 1 sc on bottom. (This resolves the 2 extra sts on side.)

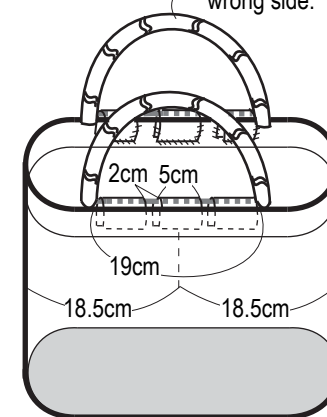
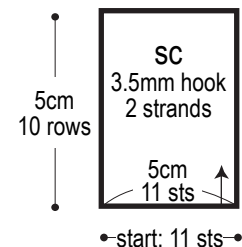
Align bottom & side piece with wrong sides facing each other; work sc through both layers.

Wrap belt pieces around handle; whipstitch on wrong side.

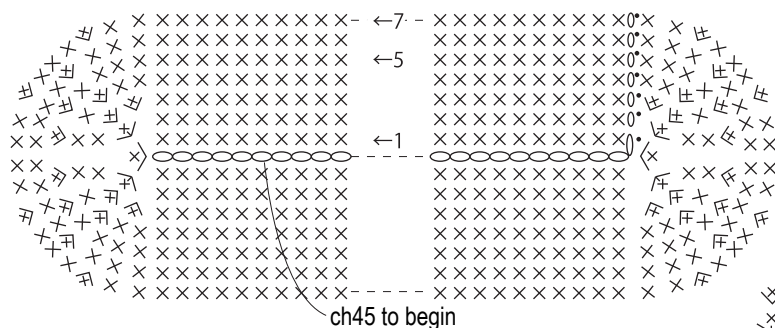
