

214ss-18 Cowl-neck Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Carta [90% cotton, 10% silk; 133 yds/122m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #65 platinum, 7 skeins [250g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cyryp [52% acrylic, 29% nylon, 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #15 sweet grape, 2 cones [85g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 102cm/40.16"
- center back neck-to-cuff 28cm/11.02"
- back length 51.5cm/20.28"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 22 sts and 33 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

❖**Note:** entire garment is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Carta and 1 strand of Cyryp).

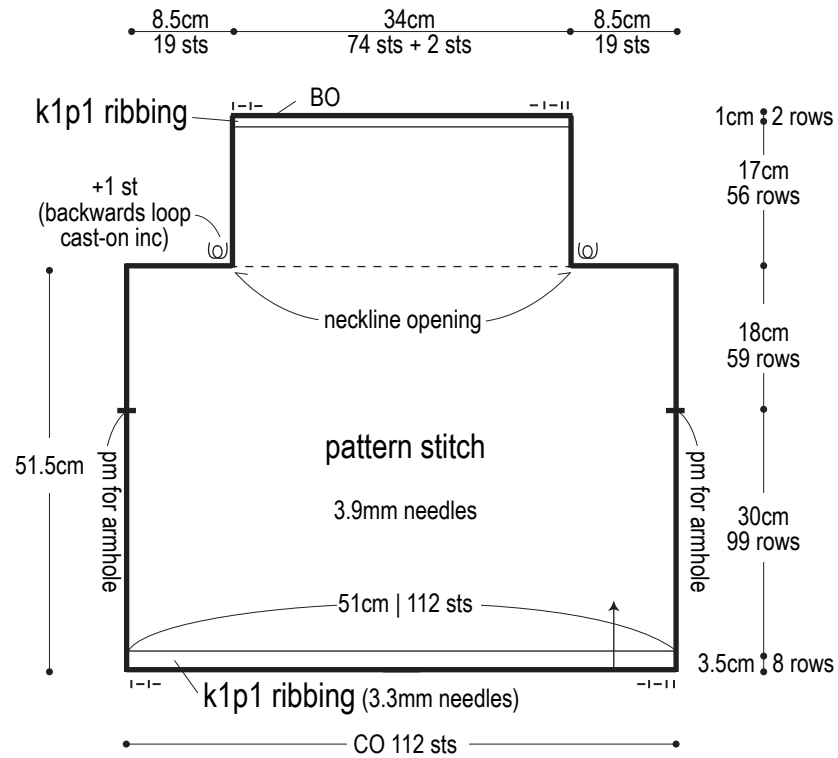
Front & back body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 7 rows of ribbing then 1 row of garter stitch, then begin working in pattern stitch up to shoulder area. For collar seam allowance, work increases at each side using backwards loop cast-on method (work the rest of the collar in pattern stitch). Work last two rows in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around armholes. Work armhole edging in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off the same way as for the collar. Seam sides from hem to cuffs in one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side). Seam sides of collar with mattress stitch.

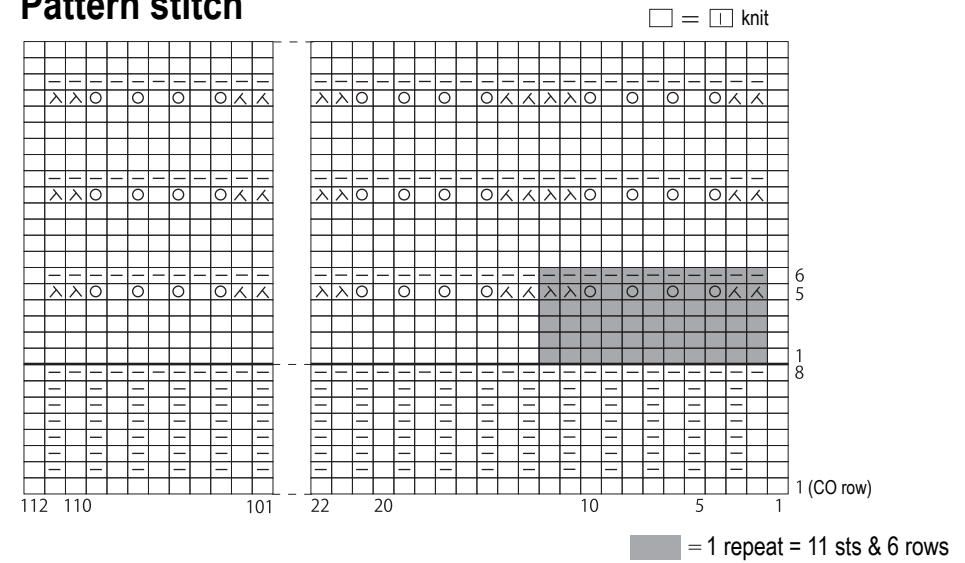
Abbreviations:
