

214ss-07 Ribbon Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Orgabits One [100% cotton; 142yds/130m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #04 powder blue, 6 skeins [230g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cyrup [52% acrylic, 29% nylon(polyamide), 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76oz./50g cone]; color #14 aqua, 2 cones [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 29cm/11.42"
- back length 60.5cm/23.82"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitches A & B: 20 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

✳️**Note:** entire garment is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Orgabits One and 1 strand of Cyrup).

Back & front body: Cast on with crochet chain cast-on method (that is, work a crochet chain, then pick up and knit from bottom loops of chain). Work in pattern stitches A and B. Work centered double decreases in skirt section of tunic where indicated. Shape armscye and neckline as follows: bind of stitches where indicated, and work decreases at edges where indicated.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Work edging B in the round around hem. At armholes, work edging B in the round. For neckline edging, start at left shoulder; work edging B' along front neckline and sc along back neckline.

Ribbon: Crochet a foundation chain to begin, then crochet the ribbon. Align center of back neckline with center of ribbon; seam ribbon to back neckline with whipstitch.


Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain stitch CO = cast on dc = double crochet (US) RE = row(s) even rep = pattern repeat(s) sc = single crochet (US)


= rows-stitches-times (for example, 2-3-4 means "every 2 rows, decrease 3 stitches; do this 4 times total")

= rounds-places-stitches-times [for evenly spaced decreases across entire width/circumference of an item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 round, decrease 3 stitches in each of 2 places across the round; do this 4 times total."






Neckline & armhole edging




Edging A

3.0mm hook




Edging B




Neckline: Edging B' & sc




Ribbon finishing




Pattern stitch B
