# 23-24-46 Basic Bulky Cap



#### Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Basic Bulky [100% merino wool; 49 yds/45m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #4 gray, 2 skeins [80g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

# Finished measurements:

• head circumference 51cm/20.08"

# Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 14 sts and 19 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

# **Knitting Tips**

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Continue in pattern stitch. On round 30, work ssk decreases as shown, which will reduce the stitch count by half. Bind off all stitches. Seam top of hat together in four places (working seam through stitches of last round) as shown in schematic.

#### Abbreviations:

k = knit

p = purl

ssk = slip, slip, knit (decrease)
