

98-9 Sawayaka Lamé Tee



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Lamé 2 [70% acrylic, 16% rayon, 10% linen, 4% polyester; 112 yds/102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #6557, 8 skeins [320g] - *discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute*

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 100cm/39.37"
- cross back width 38cm/14.96"
- back length 55cm/21.65"
- sleeve length 29cm/11.42"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 29 sts and 37 rows
- pattern stitches A and A': 29 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch according to schematic. Bind off live stitches at provisional cast-on edges of hem and cuffs.

Collar: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up live stitches around neckline and bind off, then crochet 2 rounds of sc tbl.

Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Work 2 rounds of sc tbl along cuffs and hem. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

k = knit

OH = on hold (that is, place sts on stitch holder)

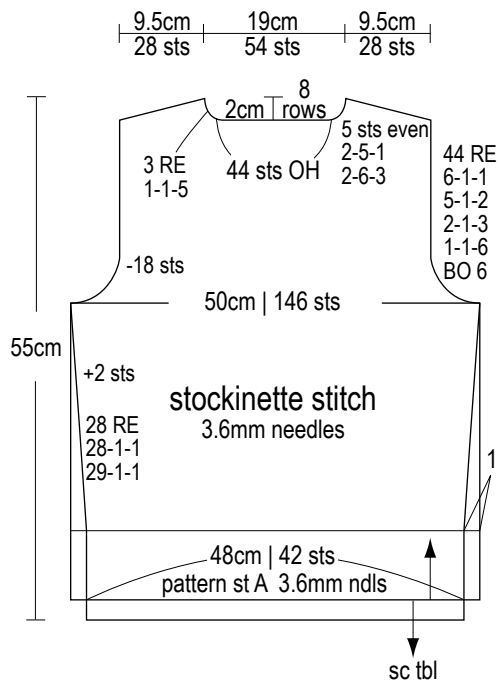
p = purl

RE = row(s) even

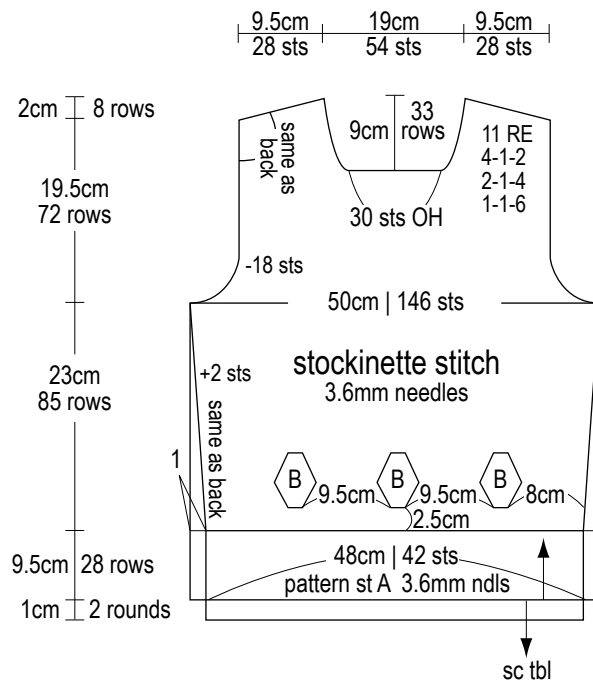
sc tbl = single crochet (US) through back loop only

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

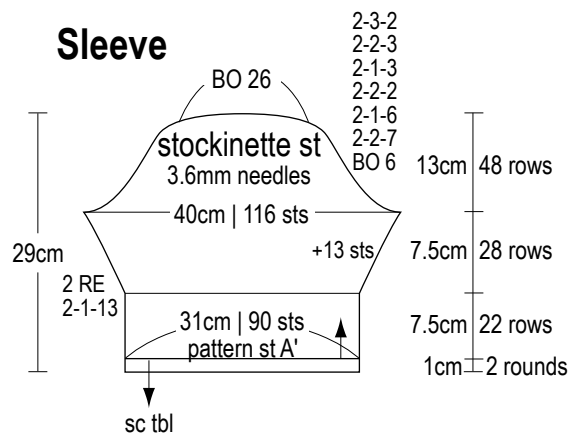

Front



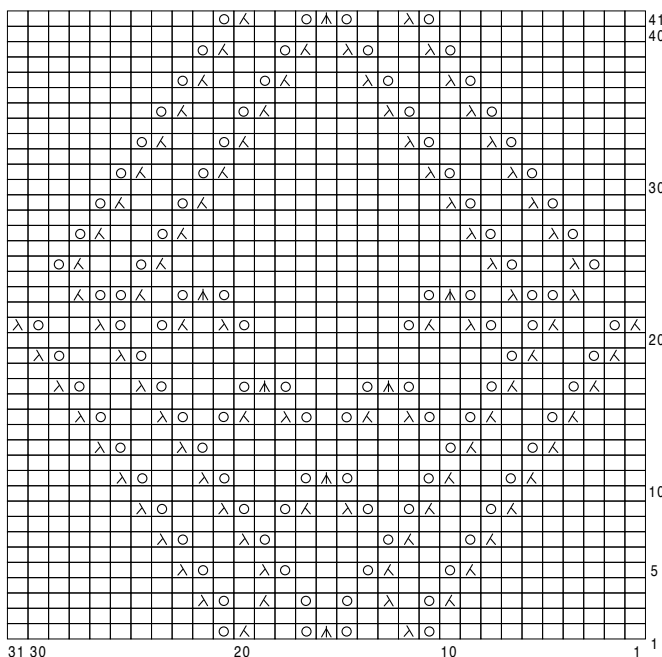
Sleeve

31-st, 41-row repeat

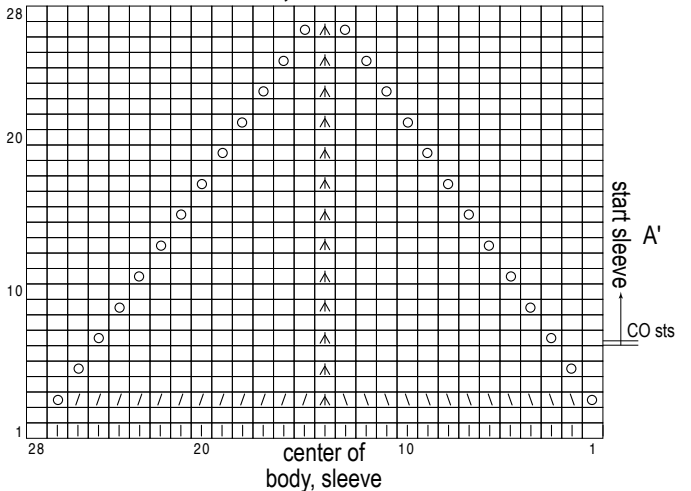
□ = □ knit
