

214s-06 Tanktop with Notched Hem



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pont du Gard [100% linen; 188yds/172m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #01 Neige, 4 skeins [150g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 87cm/34.25"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- back length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 26 sts and 41 rows
- pattern stitch B: 24 sts and 41 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work lower section in pattern stitch B, then work upper section in pattern stitch A. On one side of hem (refer to schematic for back and for front), begin working lifted increases to shape notch. Shape armscye and neckline by working fully fashioned decreases (worked 1 stitch in from the edges).

Finishing: Seam shoulders together with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides together with mattress stitch. Work sc in the round along back, front cast-on edge, and left hem. Work sc edging in the round along armholes and neckline.

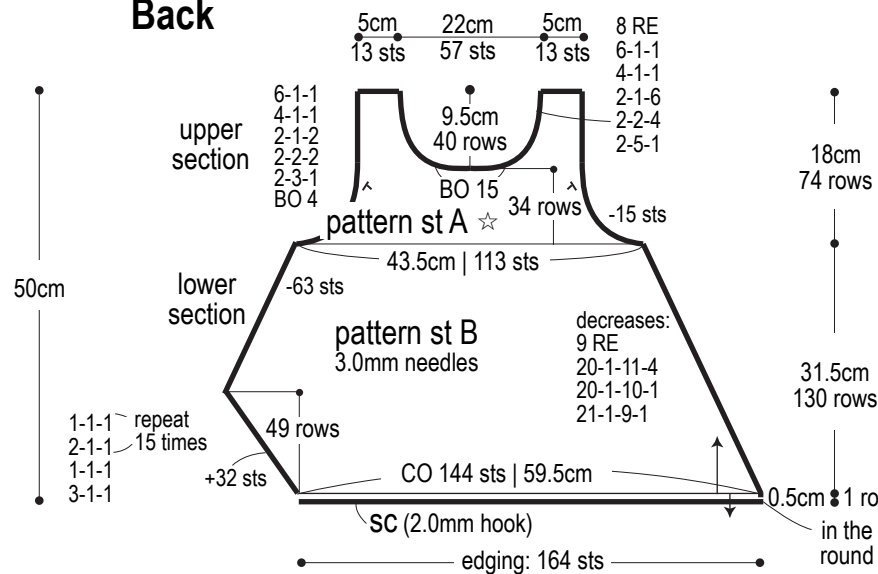
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on RE = row(s) even sc = single crochet (US) sc2tog = single crochet (US) two stitches together

= rows-stitches-times (for example, 2-3-4 means "every 2 rows, decrease 3 stitches; do this 4 times total")

= rows-stitches-places-times [for evenly spaced decreases across entire width of an item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 row, decrease 2 stitches in each of 3 places across the row; do this 4 times total."

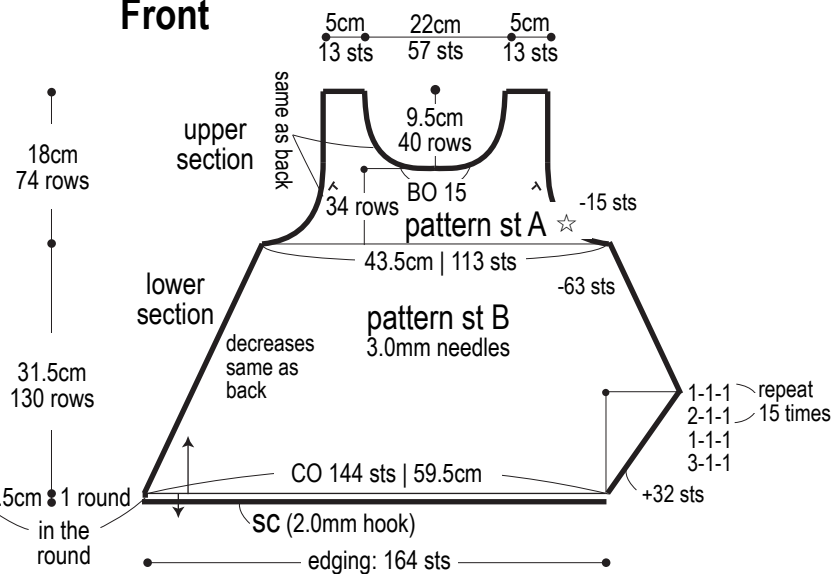

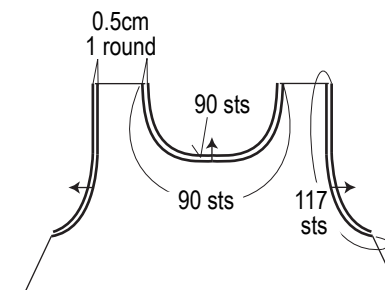

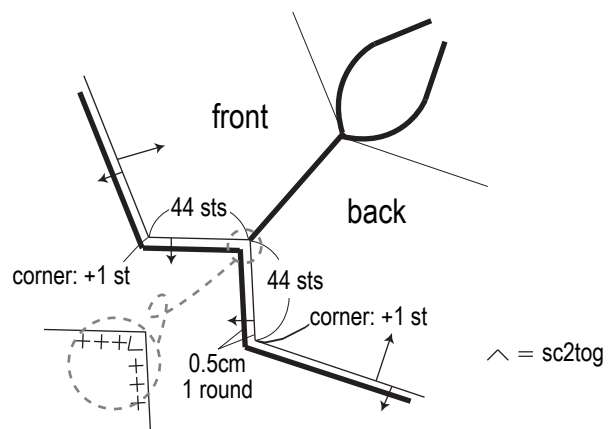
Front



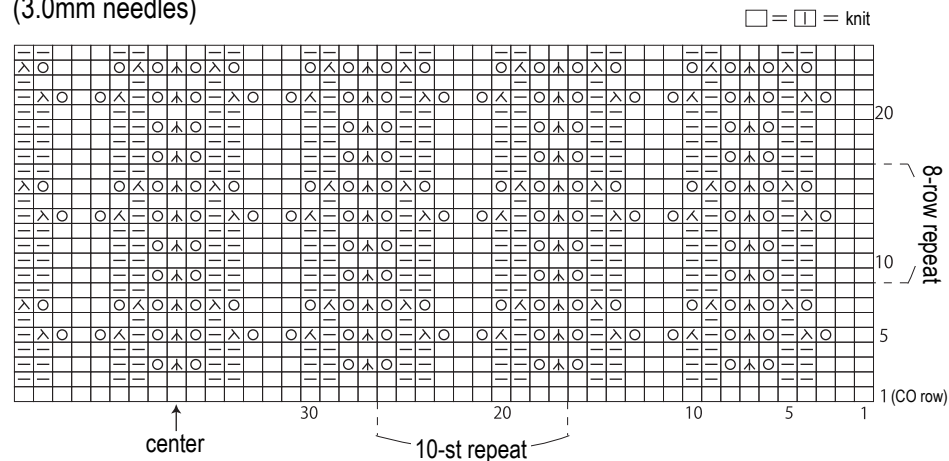
Neckline & armhole:
