

214s-17 Everyday Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180yds/165m per 1.06oz/30g skein]; color #07 emerald green, 12 skeins [360g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) and 3.5mm (US E) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 button (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- cross back width 38cm/14.96"
- back length 54cm/21.26"
- sleeve length 25cm/9.84"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 3.5mm hook): 25 sts and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✳️**Note 1:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

✳️**Note 2:** Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Back, front, and sleeves: Work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch according to schematic and pattern stitch chart.

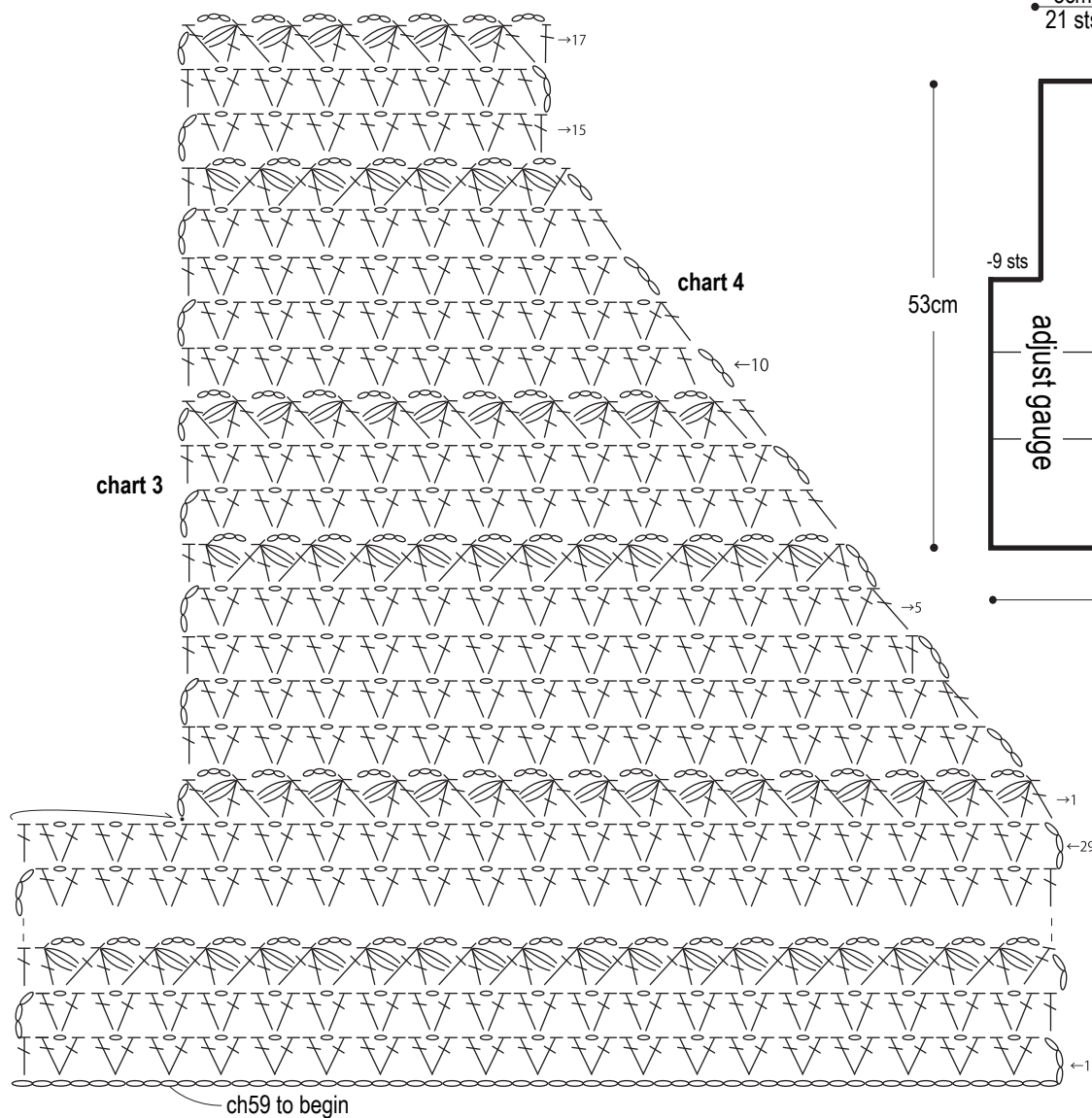
Finishing: Seam shoulders together with slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with slip stitch seam as well. Work edging at cuffs back and forth in joined rounds. Work edging around front edges, neckline, and hem in the same manner. With wrong sides facing each other, seam sleeves to body with slip stitch seam. Fasten button to left front body. Use eyelets in fabric as buttonhole.

Abbreviations:

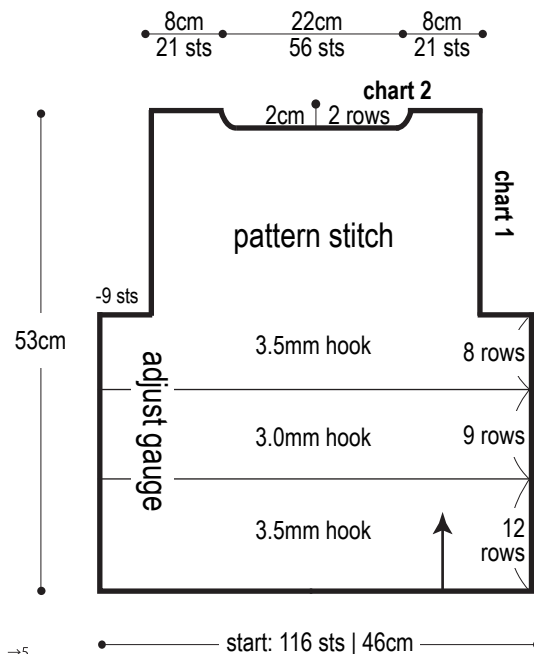
ch = chain dc = double crochet (US) hdc = half double crochet (US) sl = slip

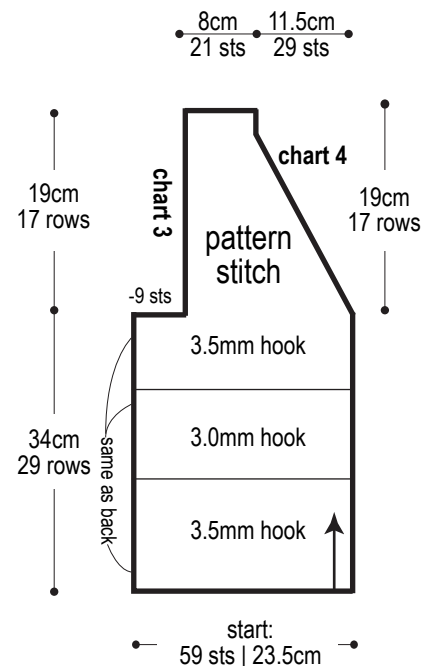
3.0 & 3.5mm hooks

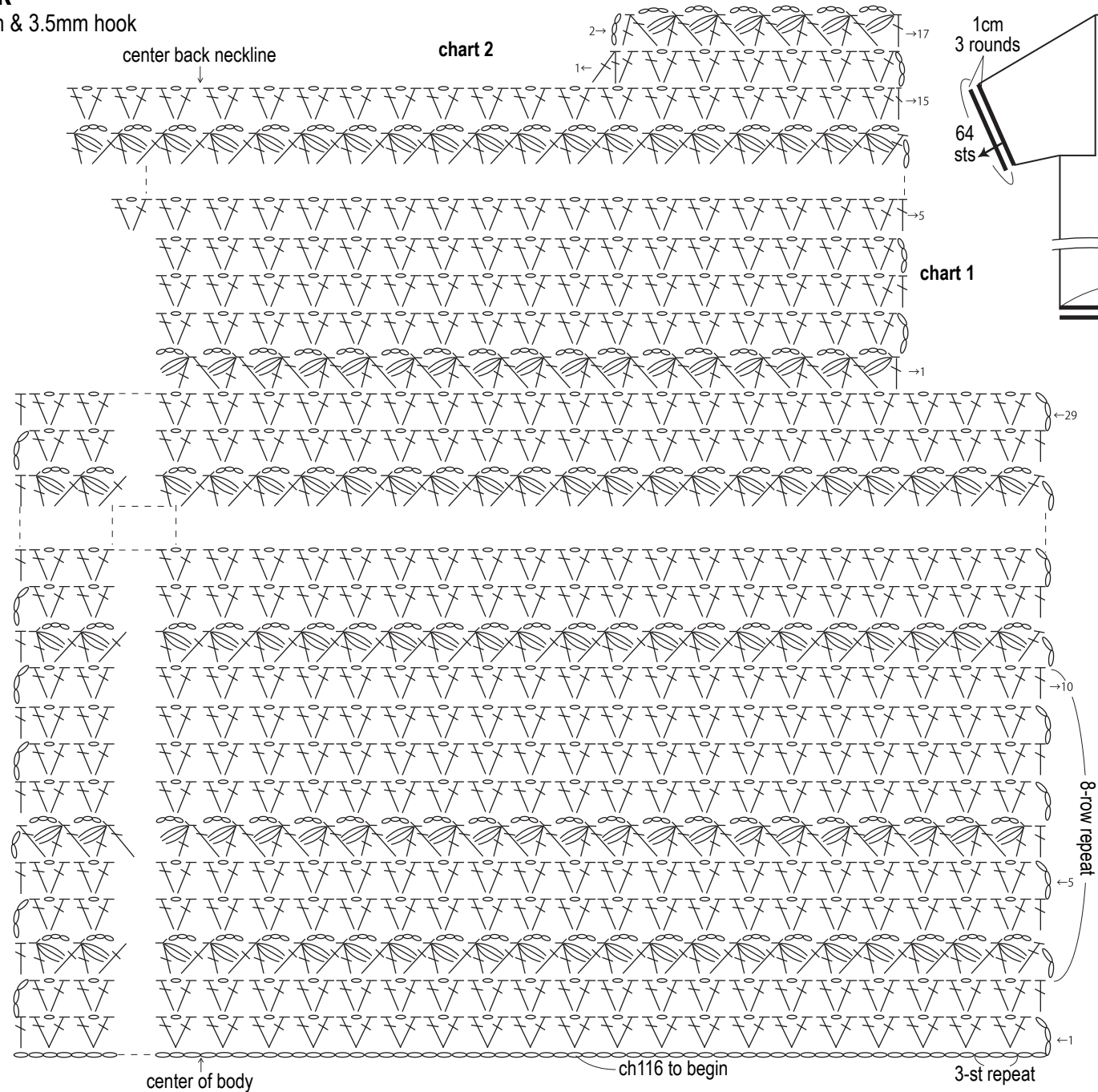

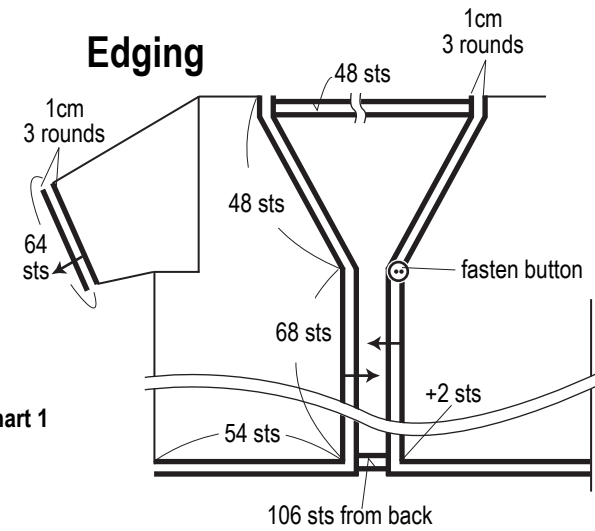

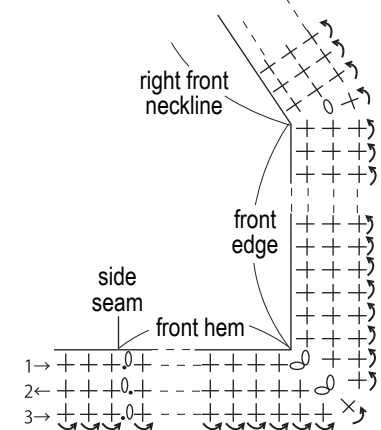

Edging

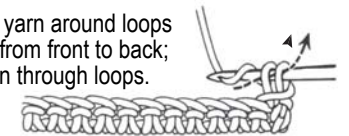


Edging (3.0mm hook)

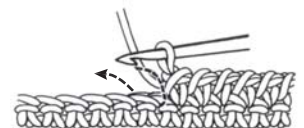


instructions

① Wrap yarn around loops on hook from front to back; draw yarn through loops.

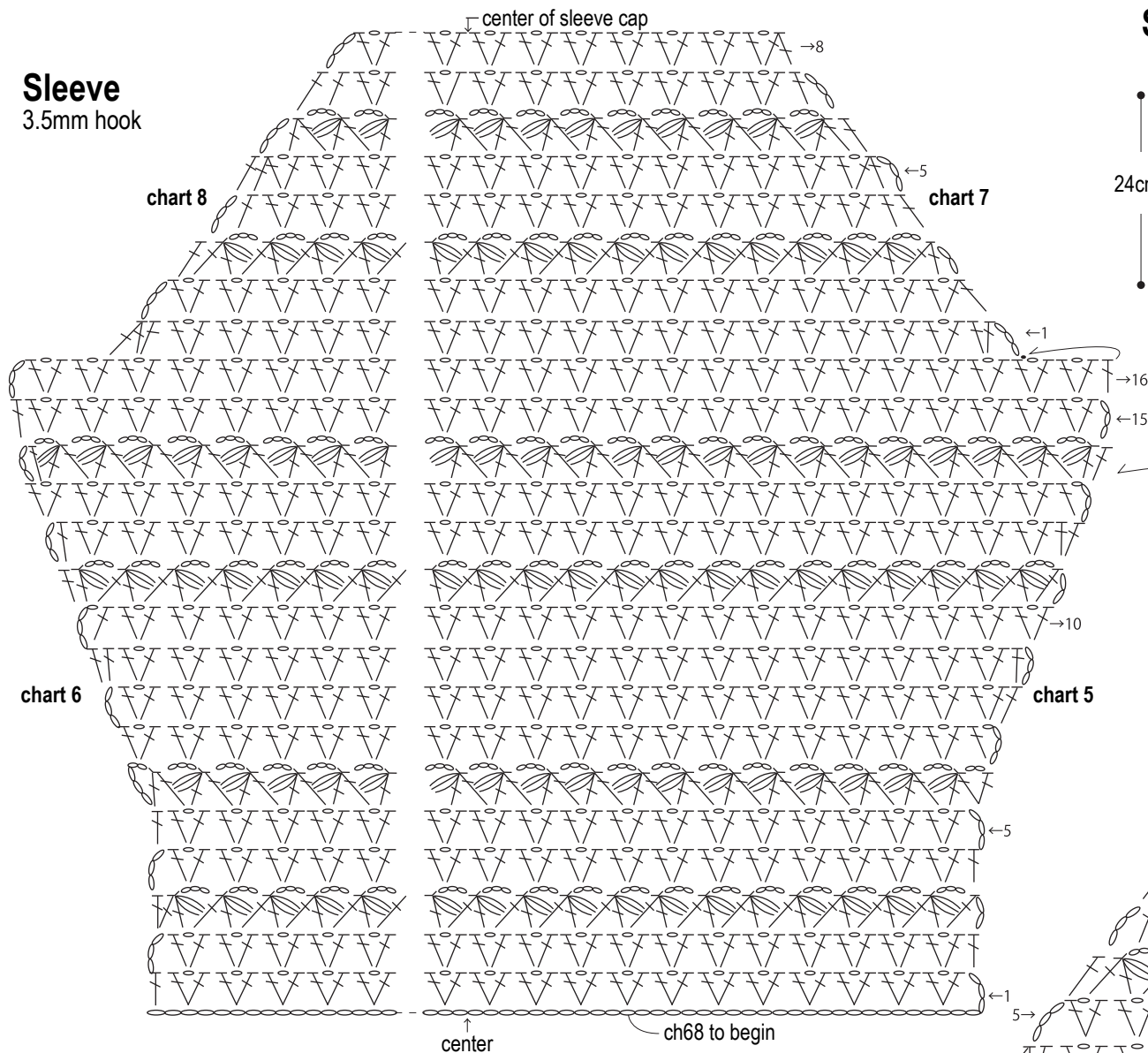

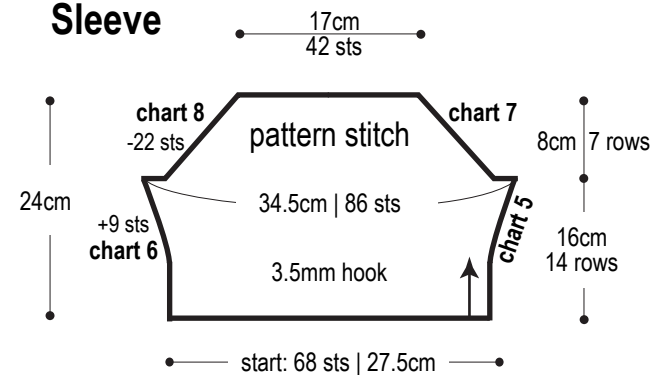


Sleeve
