366-ami Rabbit



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Rabbits [43% mohair, 41% acrylic, 16% nylon; 63yds/58m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
color #03 colette, 1 skein [35g]

Tools/Notions:

- 7mm (no exact US equivalent) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 safety eyes (8mm/0.31")
- approx. 15g polyfiber stuffing

Finished measurements:

· Please refer to finishing schematic.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve a fabric thick enough that the stuffing won't show through.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Head & torso: Create magic ring to begin. Work sc in the round, increasing and decreasing as indicated. Insert stuffing, then on the last round of the head, thread yarn tail through all stitches and cinch head shut. Sew wide end of torso together (with stomach side aligning with back side).

Arms, legs, and ears: Create magic ring to begin, then work in sc. Seam arms and legs to torso where indicated. Sew ears to head where indicated.

Finishing: Fasten safety eyes to head. Embroider nose on head with straight stitch. Sew head to torso. Crochet tail and sew in place.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain m = magic ring
