214s-02 V-neck Straight Sweater



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Le Rhone [85% ramie, 15% linen; 202yds/185m per 1.23oz/35g skein]; color #04 lavande, 10 skeins [325g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- bust 112cm/44.09"
- center back neck-to-cuff 53cm/20.87"
- back length 52.5cm/20.67"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 35 rows
pattern stitch: 23 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


❖Note: Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Back, front, and sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st and pattern stitch A. For front and back, place marker where sleeve will be attached. For back, bind off stitches at neckline. For front, shape V neck by dividing the front stitches in two, then working right and left sides separately. For sleeves, bind off all stitches when finished.


Finishing: Seam shoulders together with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides up until marker for sleeve using mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Work sc in the round along hem. Also work sc in the round along cuffs and neckline, respectively. Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work sleeve tabs in pattern stitch B. Seamtabs to sleeves where indicated. Fasten buttons to garment.





Sleeve (make 2)









Sleeve tab

Pattern stitch B 3.3mm needles




Pattern stitch A
