

214s-10 Ribbon Tanktop



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pont du Gard [100% linen; 188yds/172m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #12 rouge, 4 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 87cm/34.25"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- back length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 26 sts and 41 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on for back with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch A. Make front piece identical to back.

Finishing: Join shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Work sc in the round along hem edge. Also work sc edging in the round along each armhole and around neckline (including 1 st on hold).

Ribbons: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work ribbon in stockinette stitch. Make second ribbon identical to first. Tie one ribbon around each shoulder section.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

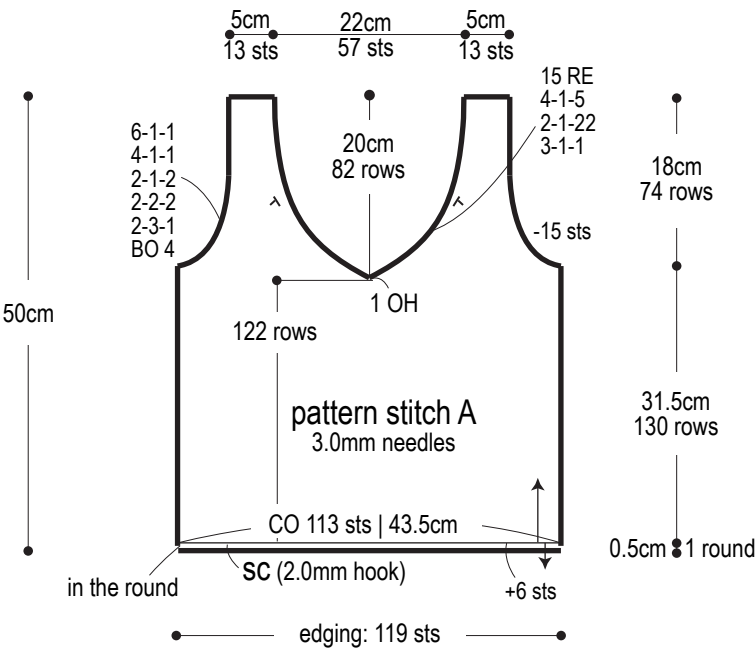
OH = on hold (that is, place st(s) on stitch holder)

RE = row(s) even

sc = single crochet (US)

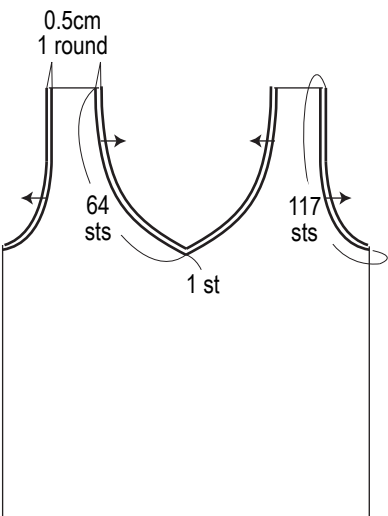

Body (make 2)

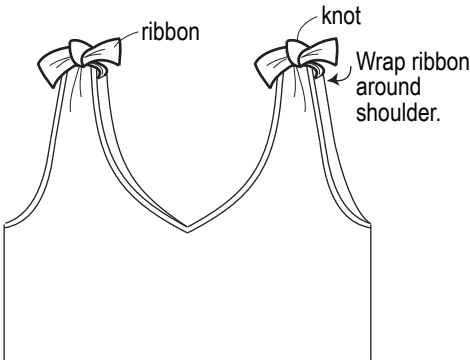


Neckline & armhole edging

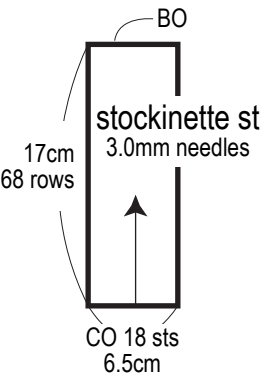
sc, 2.0mm hook



Knot ribbons at shoulders

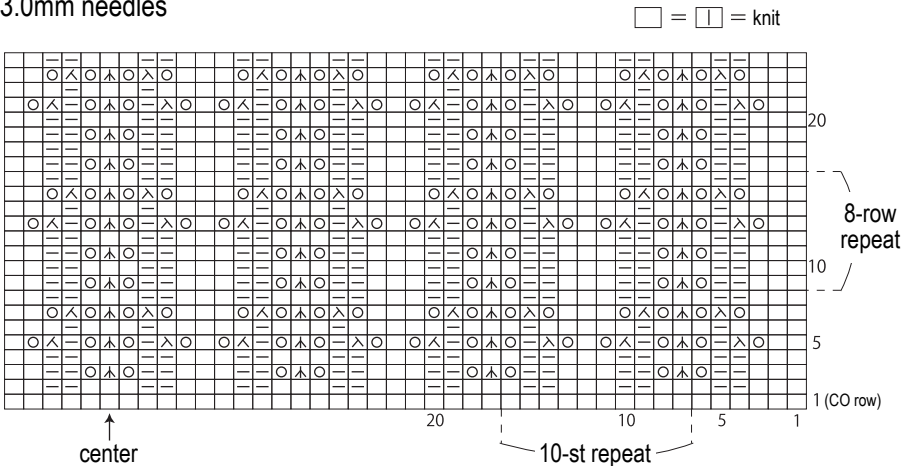


Ribbon (make 2)
