

# 214s-16 Short-sleeve Tunic



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Garden [100% silk; 208yds/190m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
  - size M: color #13 baby blue, 4 skeins [150g]
  - size L: color #13 baby blue, 5 skeins [180g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cyrup [52% acrylic, 29% nylon (polyamide), 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492yds/450m per 1.76oz/50g skein];
  - size M: color #14 aqua, 2 skeins [80g]
  - size L: color #14 aqua, 2 skeins [95g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

❖**Note:** Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together: 1 strand of Silk Garden and 1 strand of Cyrup.

**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 6 rows of garter stitch, then continue in pattern stitch A. Change needle size, then continue in pattern stitch A. Work in pattern stitch B, working decreases on first row. Shape armholes and neckline by binding off stitches where indicated and by working decreases at the edges where indicated.

**Sleeve:** Start as for body; work 6 rows of garter stitch. Work in pattern stitch A and then in pattern stitch B, working decreases of first row of pattern stitch B. Shape sleeve cap by binding off stitches where indicated and by working decreases at the edges where indicated.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Crochet edging around neckline in the round. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

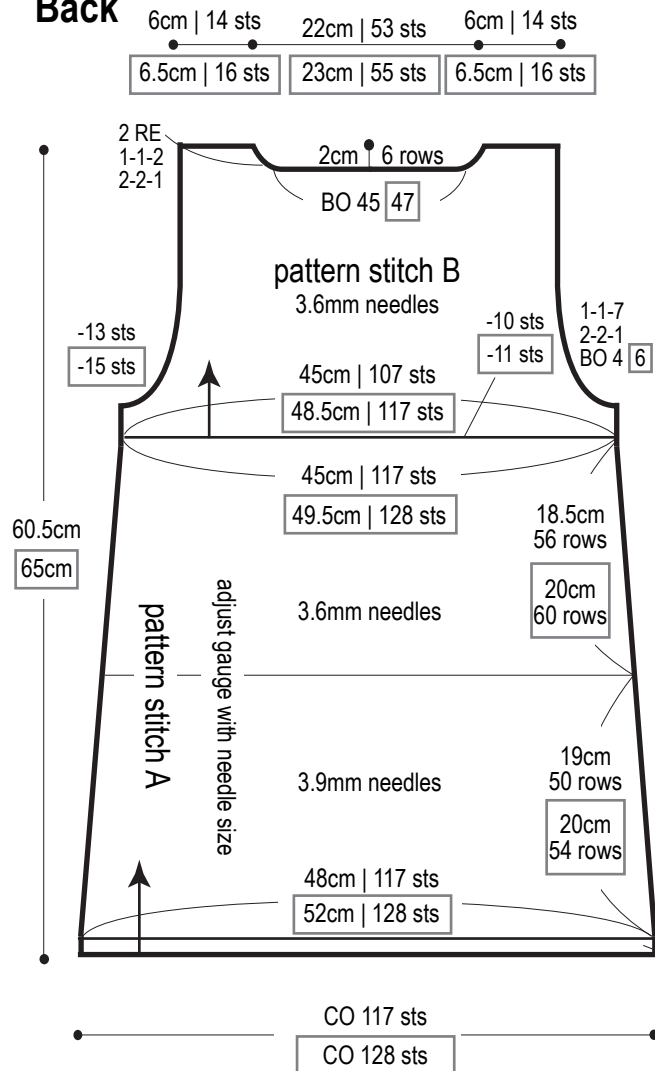

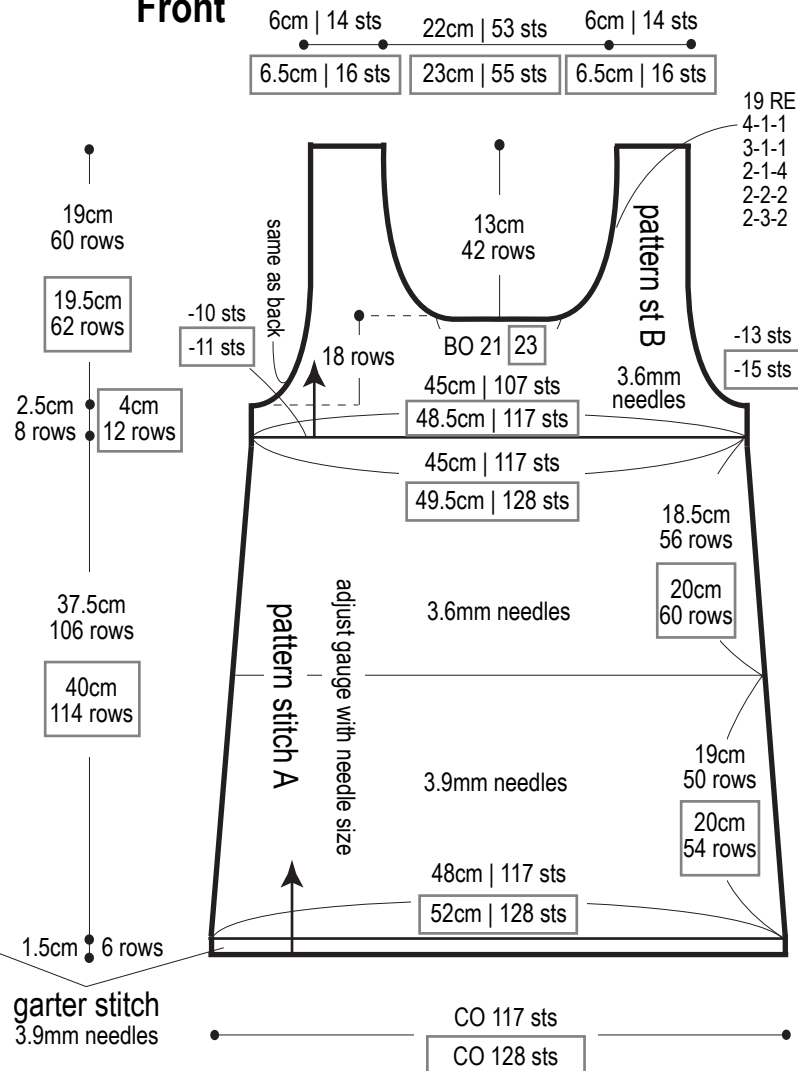

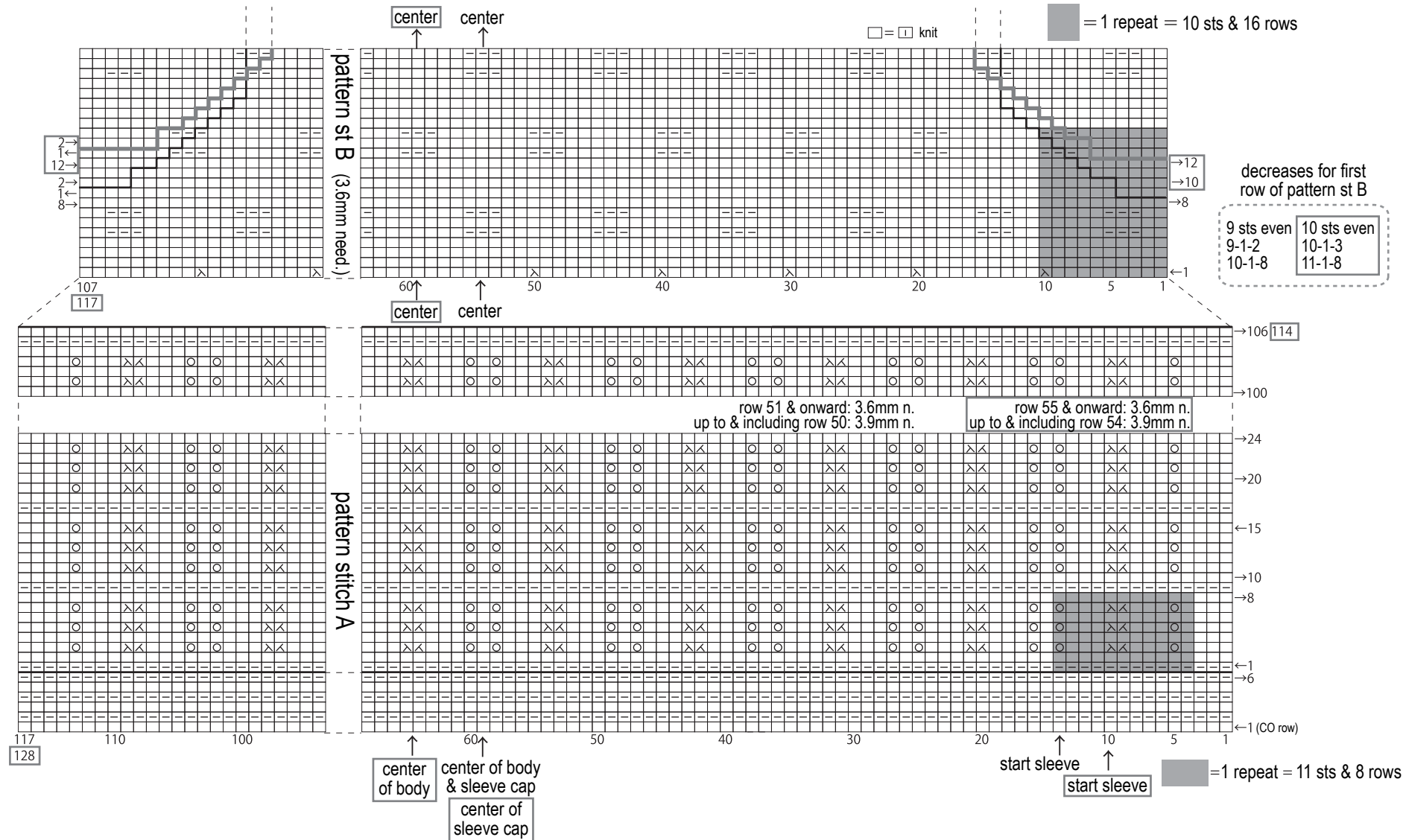

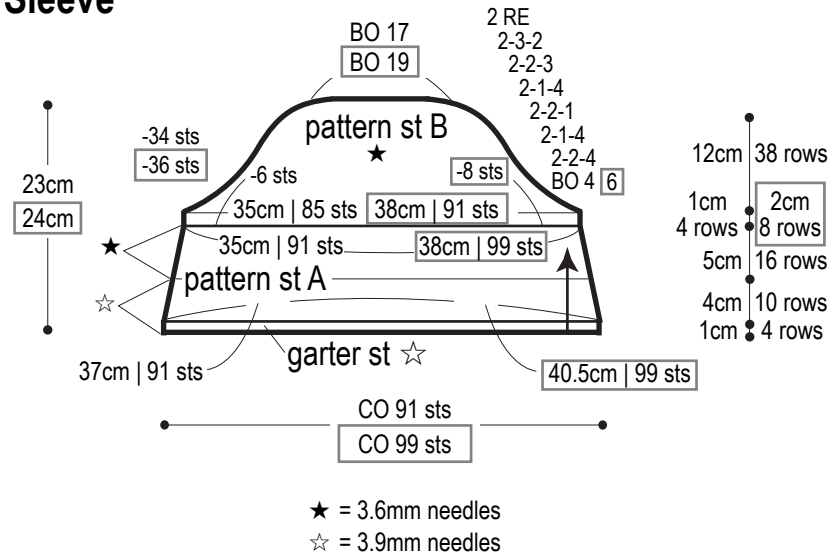

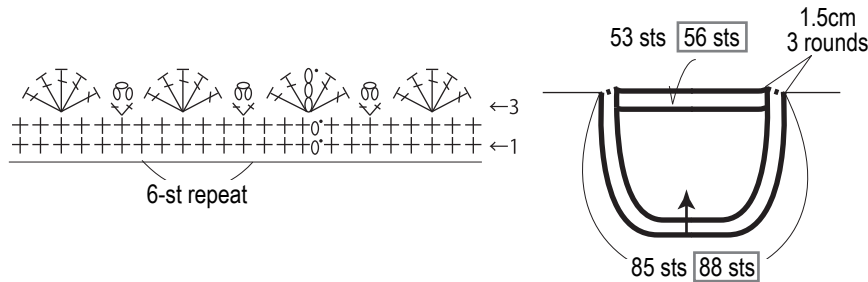
