

214s-18 Armwarmers



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180yds/165m per 1.06oz/30g skein]; color #02 Black, 2 skeins [60g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) and 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- length 31.5cm/12.40"
- palm circumference 20cm/7.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 2.0mm crochet hook): 36.5 sts and 14.5 rows
- pattern stitch (with 2.3mm crochet hook): 32.5 sts and 13.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

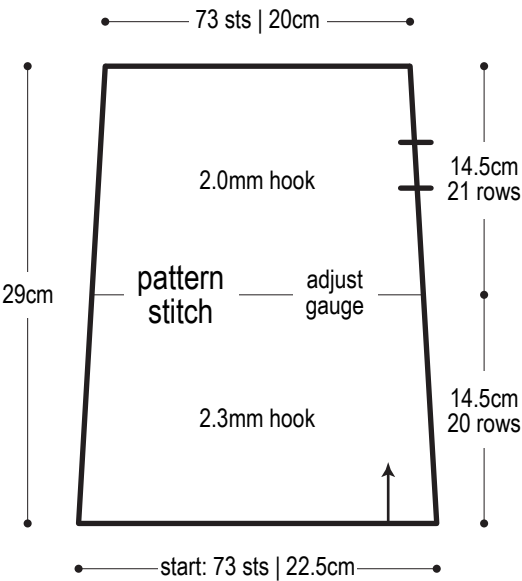
Armwarmers: Work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch, changing hook size when indicated to alter gauge. Make second armwarmer identical to the first.

Finishing: Leaving an opening unseamed for the thumb, seam sides together with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Work edging in the round along both ends of each armwarmer (that is, the foundation chain edge and the bind-off edge).

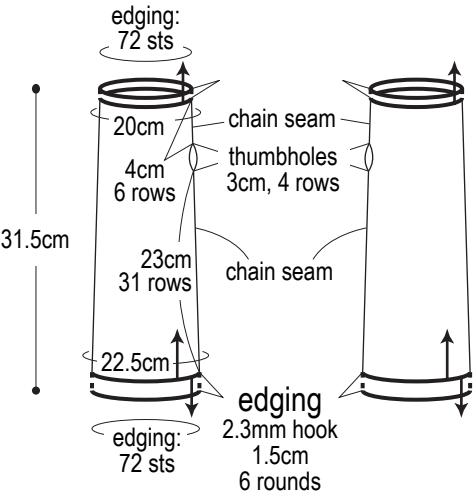
Abbreviations:

ch = chain

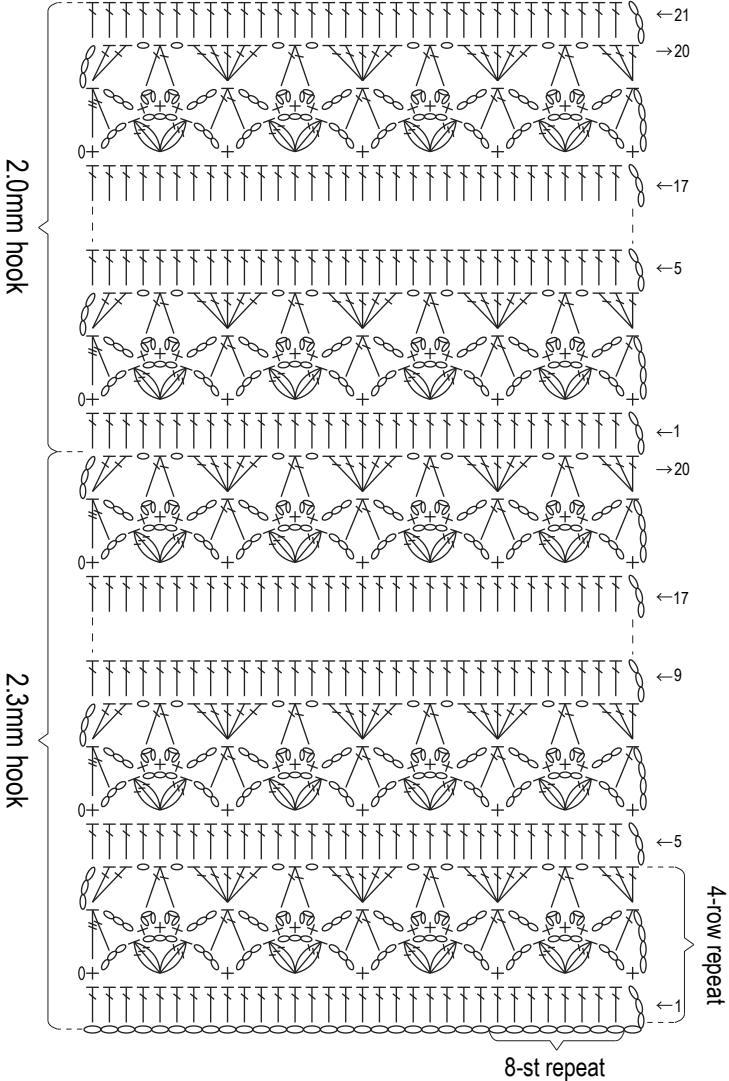
Armwarmer (make 2)
