

23-11 French-sleeve Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [100% cotton; 416yds/380m per 3.53oz/100g skein]; color #21 papaya orange, 2 skeins [190g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 104cm/40.94"
- back length 51.5cm/20.28"
- center back neck-to-cuff 27.5cm/10.83"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 29 sts and 44 rows
- pattern stitch B: 29 sts and 37 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

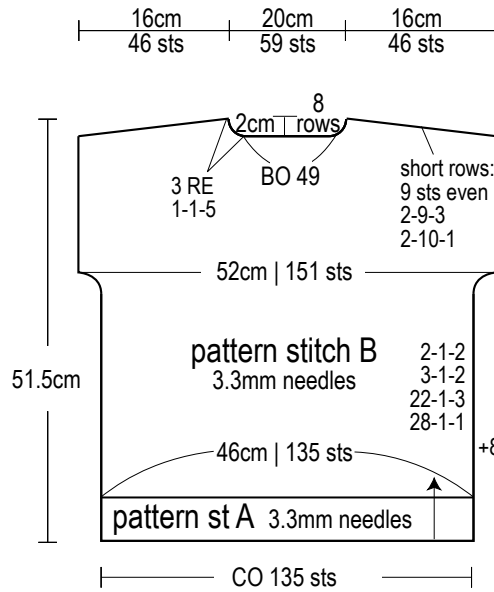
Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work from the bottom up. Shape sides with lifted increases. Shape neckline by binding off stitches and working decreases as indicated. Shape shoulders with short rows, leaving stitches on the needles after final row (that is, do not bind off the stitches).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work garter stitch in the round. Bind off. Work garter stitch edging at cuffs in the same manner.

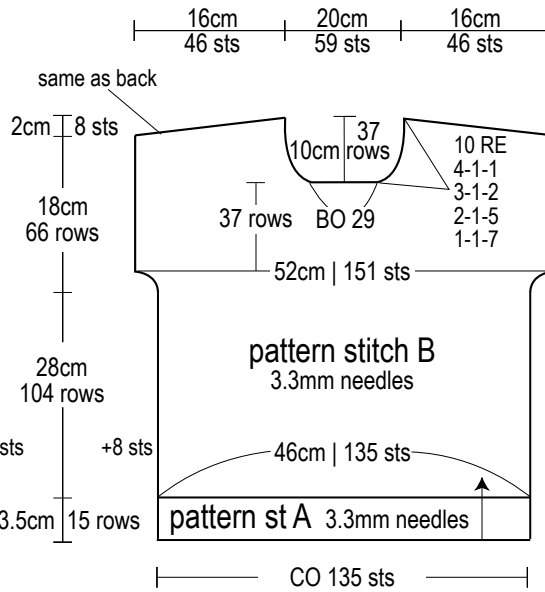

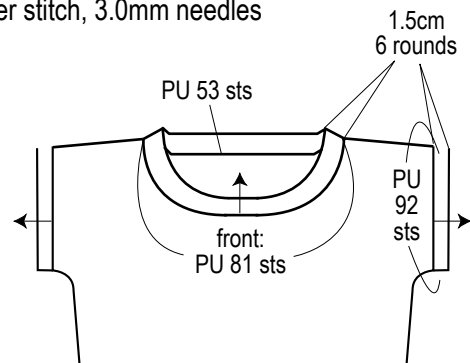


Front
