Suggested yarn:

- version A: Pierrot Yarns Ami Cotton Bulky [100% cotton; 115yds/105m per 3.53oz/100g skein]; color #02 beige, 4 skeins [370g]
- version B: Pierrot Yarns Ami Cotton Space Dye Bulky [100% cotton; 115yds/105m per 3.53oz/100g skein]; color #34 apricot, 4 skeins [370g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- felt pouch for lining: 700mm/27.56" x 600mm/23.62"
- 500g plastic bean bag pellets
- · small amount of polyfiber or cotton stuffing

Finished measurements:

- height (not including stem): 36cm/14.17"
- circumference: 110cm/43.31"

Note that the finished measurements reflect the size after finishing with a steam iron.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 16 sts and 16.5 rows
- garter stitch: 10.5 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.



Summary

Bottom: Create magic ring to begin, then work in sc in the round according to chart.

Side: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 80 rows in garter stitch. After 80th row, divide into six sections; work evenly spaced decreases in each section. After working last row, place live stitches on stitch holder(s).

Finishing: With right side facing you, seam side piece together with mattress stitch to form a tube. Seam until marker but do not weave in ends (leave yarn tail available for later use). Place bottom and side pieces together with wrong sides facing you; seam together with whipstitch, forming small gathers in side piece as you seam. Insert felt lining pouch into the bean bag. Fill it with bean bag pellets, then sew top of pouch shut so that pellets do not escape. Seam remaining area of side with mattress stitch. Insert stuffing into top of bean bag. Arrange it smoothly, then thread yarn through live stitches of last row and cinch top of bean bag shut. Crochet leaf and stem; fasten to bean bag.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

CO = cast on


m = magic ring

OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

pm = place marker


sc = single crochet (US)

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times





Bottom: schematic
