

214s-05 Little Flowers Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Silk Ramie [70% plant fiber, 30% silk; 514yds/470m per 3.53oz/100g skein];
 - small size: color #24 lime light green, 2 skeins [175g]
 - large size: color #24 lime light green, 3 skeins [230g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- Small size:
 - bust 88cm/34.65"
 - cross back width 33cm/12.99"
 - back length 55cm/21.65"
 - sleeve length 15cm/5.91"
- Large size:
 - bust 95cm/37.40"
 - cross back width 36.5cm/14.37"
 - back length 60cm/23.62"
 - sleeve length 16cm/6.30"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (with 3.0mm needles): 29 sts and 37 rows
- continuous motif A (with 2.3mm hook): 1 pattern repeat = 3.5cm/1.38" and 10.5 rows = 10cm/4"

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Upper body and sleeves: Work crochet chain cast-on method (using same color yarn as the garment). Work in stockinette stitch. Work 1 row of sc along foundation chain.


Lower body: Crochet lower body in continuous motif A and continuous motif A'.

Finishing: With right sides facing each other, seam upper and lower body together with chain sts and sc sts. Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam continuous motif section of sides with chain sts and sc sts; seam stockinette st section of sides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Working edging A in the round around neckline and edging A' in the round around cuffs.


Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on dc = double crochet (US) RE = row(s) even rep = pattern repeat(s) sc = single crochet (US) #-#-# = rows-stitches-times




Front



Sleeve




Edging A'

2.3mm hook




Continuous motif method & seam locations

2.3mm hook


continuous motif A'

↪ = odd row ↩ = even row


↪ = join with slip stitch


