

214ss-12 Corsage



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Mulberry [100% silk; 136yds/124m per 1.76oz/50g skein]; color #07 antique green, 1 skein [10g]
- Pierrot Yarns CYRUP [52% acrylic, 29% nylon (polyamide), 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492yds/450m per 1.76oz/50g skein]; color #21 green tea, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 brooch pin

Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Please use hook size necessary to achieve a firm fabric.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Flowers & leaves: Referring to charts, make 7 of the 3 types of small flowers and 2 leaves.

Finishing: Crochet base piece. Arrange the 7 flower pieces and 2 leaf pieces on top of the base as you desire and secure in place. Fasten brooch pin to back of base piece.

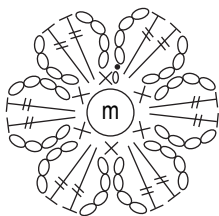
Abbreviations:

Flower A: make 5

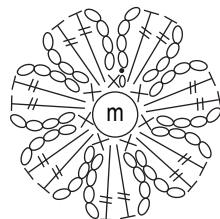
2.5mm hook

Flower B: make 2

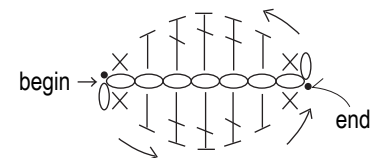
2.5mm hook



- 4) 1 strand of Mulberry (make 2)

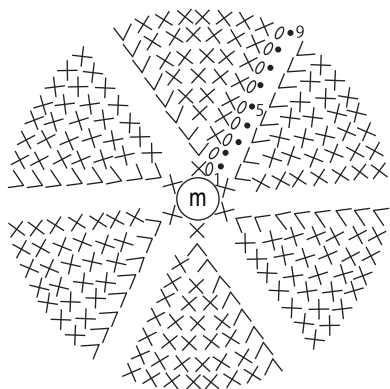
Leaf: make 2

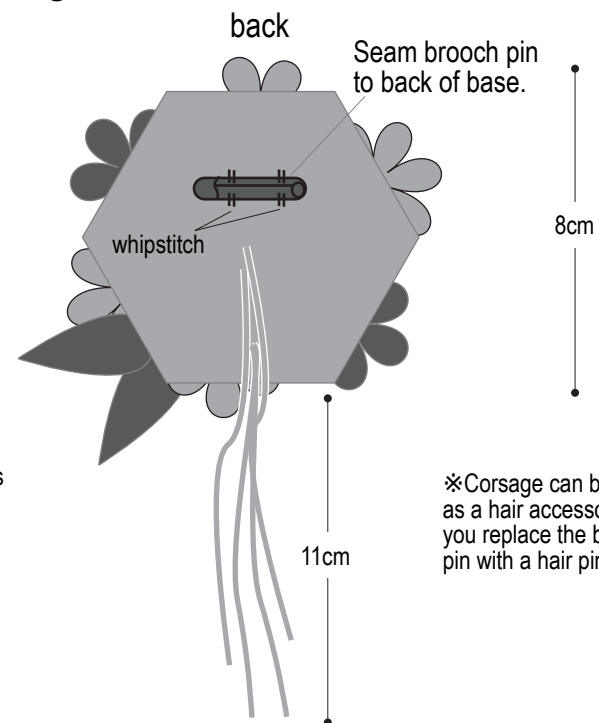
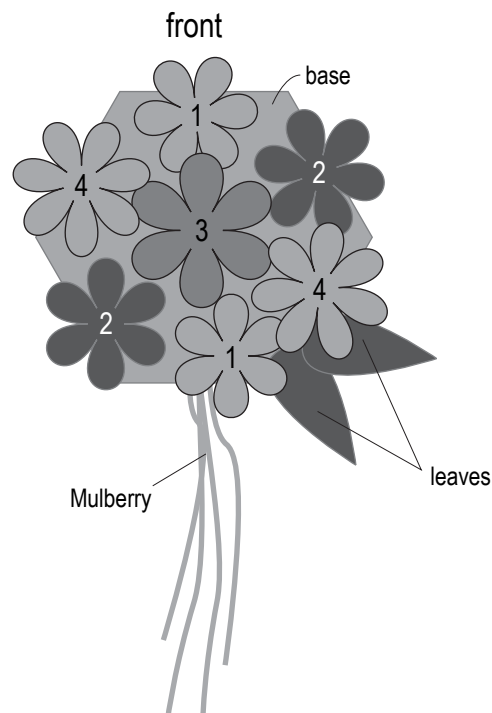
