

Shiori Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Shiori Keito-Zakka Stores [90% wool, 10% merino; 157yds/144m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #03 raspberry pink, 9 skeins [335g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) and 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- back length 65cm/25.59"
- sleeve length 15.5cm/6.10"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 42 sts and 40 rows
- stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work lower section in k1p1 ribbing and in stockinette stitch as indicated in schematic. Continue to upper section, working in pattern stitch with one stockinette stitch panel on each side.

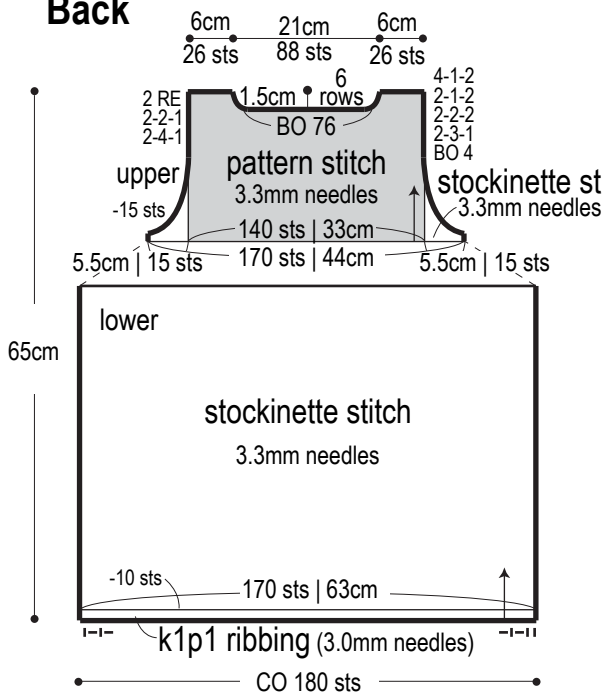
Sleeve: Cast on with crochet chain cast-on method (using the same color yarn). Seam sleeve underside with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches from cast-on edge; work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders together with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern as for sleeve. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

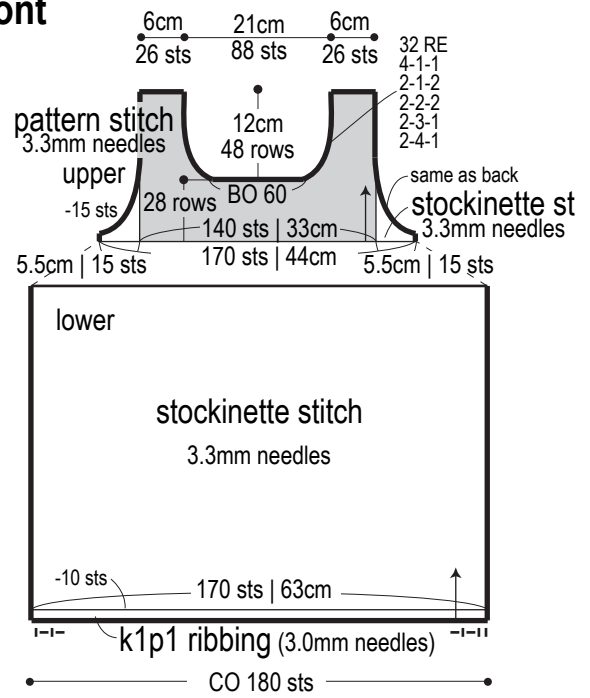
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
= rows-stitches-times

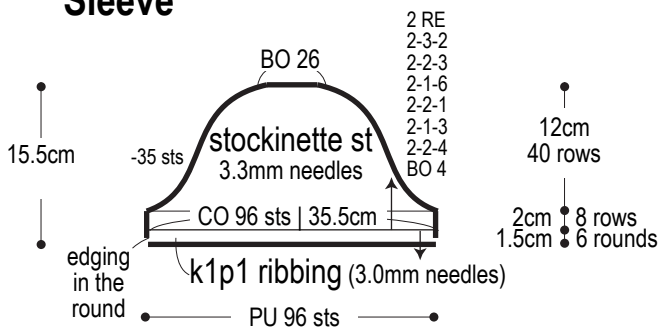

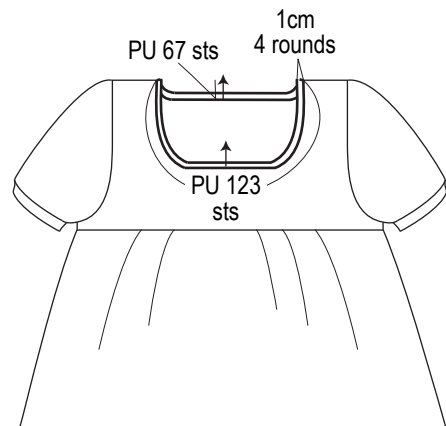
□ = pattern stitch
