211-27 Cotton Neat Necktie



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat [100% cotton; 58 yds/53m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #604 sky blue, 1 skein [5g]
 - color #608 violet, 1 skein [5g]
 - color #624 dark blue-gray, 2 skeins [55g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) and 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width (at widest section) 5cm/1.97"
- length 158cm/62.20"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• stockinette stitch: 18 sts and 23 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Cast on 18 stitches with long-tail cast-on method, then join and work in the round. Referring to schematic, work ribbing with 4.5mm needles, then continue in stockinette stitch with 5.1mm needles. Continue in stockinette, working stripes in colors A and B as indicated. Bind off after last round. Block with steam iron. Seam keeper (loop) piece to back approximately 15cm/5.91" from bind-off edge.

*Increases and decreases are worked in two places at back center.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

ch = chain stitch

CO = cast on

sc = single crochet (US)

st st = stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
