

# 214a-16 Dolman Sleeve Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Chiffon [100% alpaca; 117yds/107m per 1.06oz/30g skein];
  - color #56 coconut beige, 1 skein [30g]
  - color #57 vermilion, 19 skeins [570g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 62.5cm/24.61"
- back length 61cm/24.02"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- twisted k1p1 ribbing: 20 sts and 30 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 24 sts and 34 rows
- pattern stitch: 26.5 sts and 12 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

✳️**Note:** entire body worked with 2 strands of color 57 held together. Back hem peplum section is crocheted with 2.5mm hook and 1 strand of color 56.

**Back:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in twisted k1p1 ribbing from right sleeve sideways. Work side, increasing as indicated. When you reach the hem, work body section even (that is, with no increasing or decreasing). Then continue towards other sleeve, binding off stitches and decreasing as indicated. Bind off.


**Front:** Work as for back, but also shape neckline by increasing and decreasing as indicated.

**Finishing:** Pick up stitches from hem. Work k1p1 ribbing; bind off in pattern. Crochet peplum section for back hem, then whipstitch it to ribbing of back hem. Seam shoulders with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around cuffs and neckline, respectively, and work k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides and sleeve undersides loosely with crochet slip stitch seam.


## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off    ch = chain stitch    CO = cast on    PU = pick up    RE = row(s) even    rep = pattern repeat(s)    #-#-# = rows-stitches-times




## Collar: k1p1 ribbing

3.3mm DPNs




## Cuff

3.3mm needles





## Twisted k1p1 ribbing
