

214a-18 Mosaic Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% merino; 103yds/94m per 1.06oz/30g skein];
 - color #205 deep navy, 7 skeins [205g]
 - color #208 aqua green, 5 skeins [140g]
 - color #214 crimson, 5 skeins [140g]
 - color #227 vanilla beige, 5 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6 buttons (20mm/0.79")

Finished measurements:

- bust 93cm/36.61"
- cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- back length 57cm/22.44"
- sleeve length 56cm/22.04"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 26 sts and 20 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 24 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet or knitting style. Change hook or needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body & sleeves: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch. Two rows make one pattern repeat, but in pattern repeat for stripes is 8 rows (2 rows per color), carrying the yarn up the side rather than cutting yarn for each color change. However, for curves in shaped areas, cut yarn every 2 rows for color changes and join new color. For shaping of armscye, neckline, sleeve sides, and sleeve caps, refer to charts. (The back, right front, and left front are worked in one piece up until armscye shaping begins.)

Finishing: Seam shoulders with whipstitch. With knitting needles and color #205 deep navy, pick up stitches around hem and cuffs, respectively; work edging in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Pick up stitches along each front edge; work buttonband in k1p1 ribbing. Be sure to work buttonholes in right buttonband. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off, then fold ribbing to inside; tack down to first row of ribbing with whipstitch. Join sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain stitch k = knit stitch p = purl stitch PU = pick up rep = pattern repeat(s)

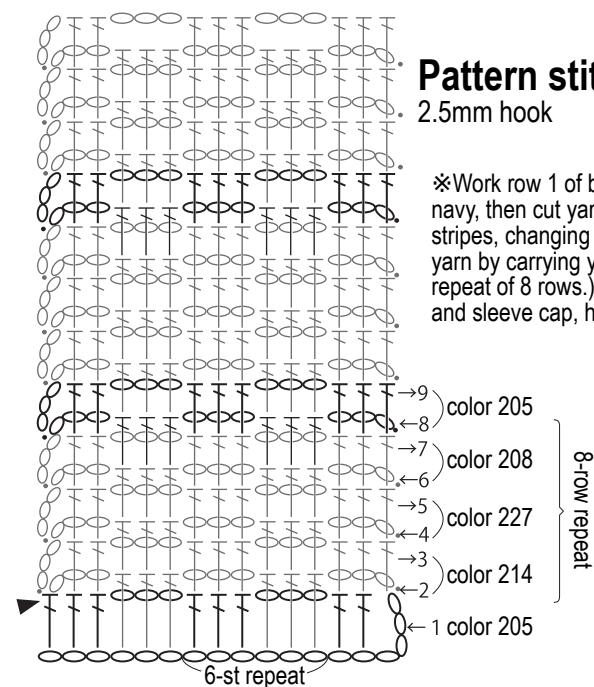

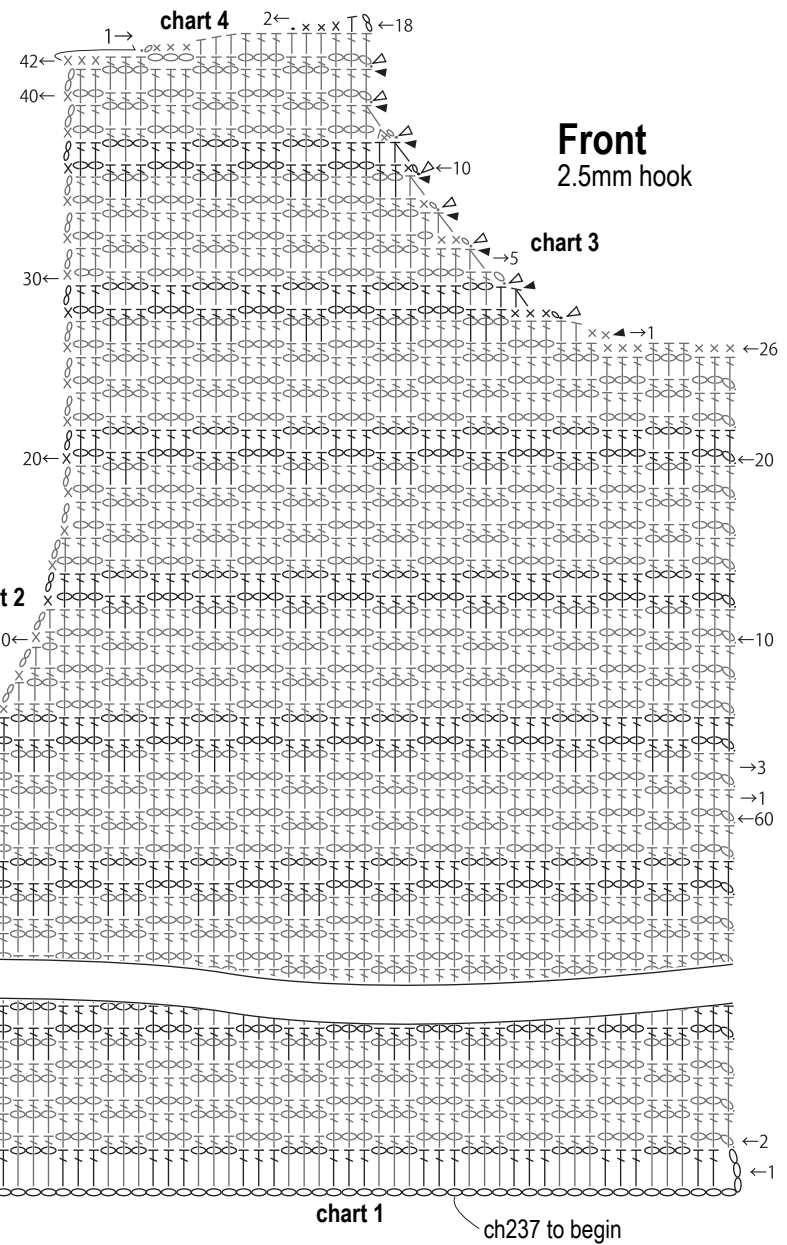
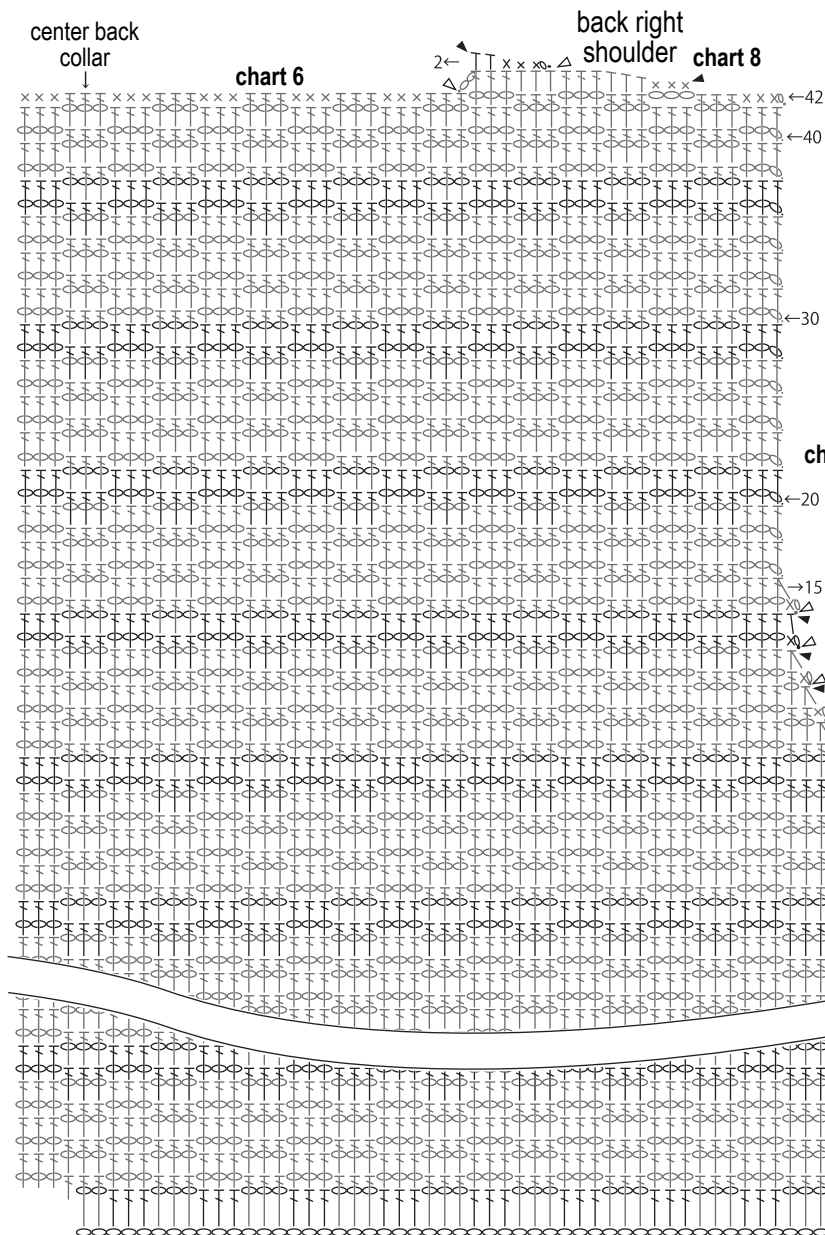
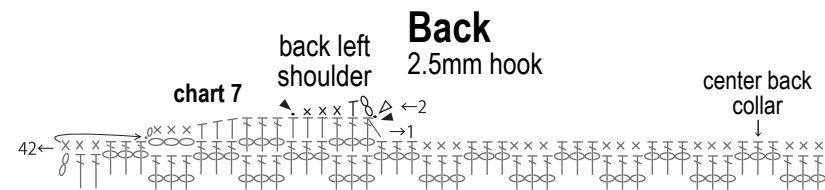

*Work row 1 of body and sleeves with #205 deep navy, then cut yarn. Starting from row 2, work in stripes, changing color every 2 rows without cutting yarn by carrying yarn up sides. (Total pattern repeat of 8 rows.) For curves of armscye, neckline, and sleeve cap, however, cut yarn for stripes.
