

27-28-3 Nijiro Loop Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nijiro Loop [29.1% nylon, 28.5% wool, 24.7% acrylic, 17.7% rayon; 50yds/46m per 1.06oz/30g skein]; color #1 variegated blue, 5 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- back length 48cm/18.90"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 16 sts and 8 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Front & back body: Work foundation chain to begin, then work front/back in pattern stitch according to chart.

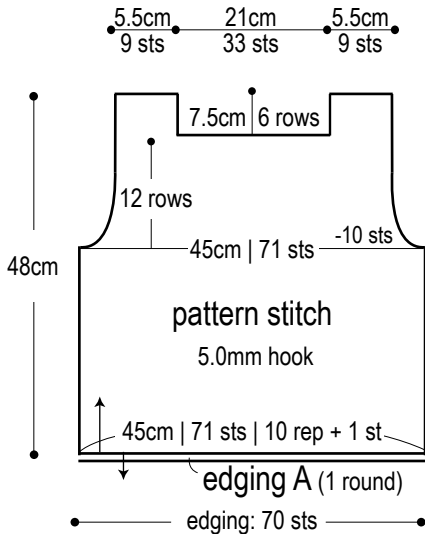
Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain stitch and slip stitch as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides with chain seam. Work one round of either edging A or edging B along hem, armholes, and neckline, respectively (see schematics for specifics).

Abbreviations:

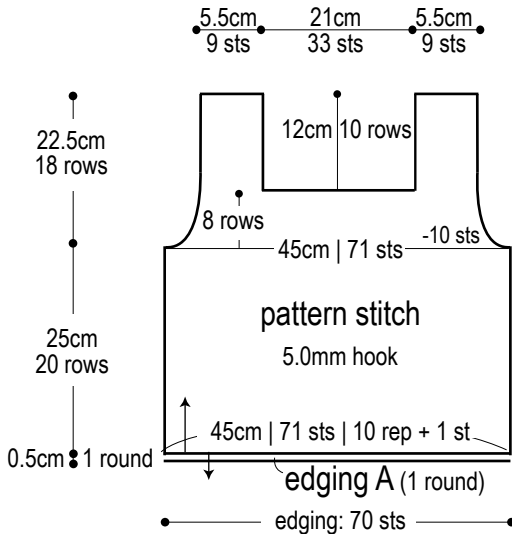
ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)

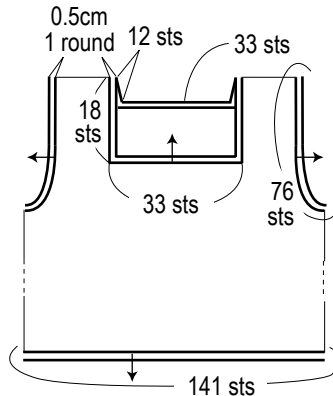

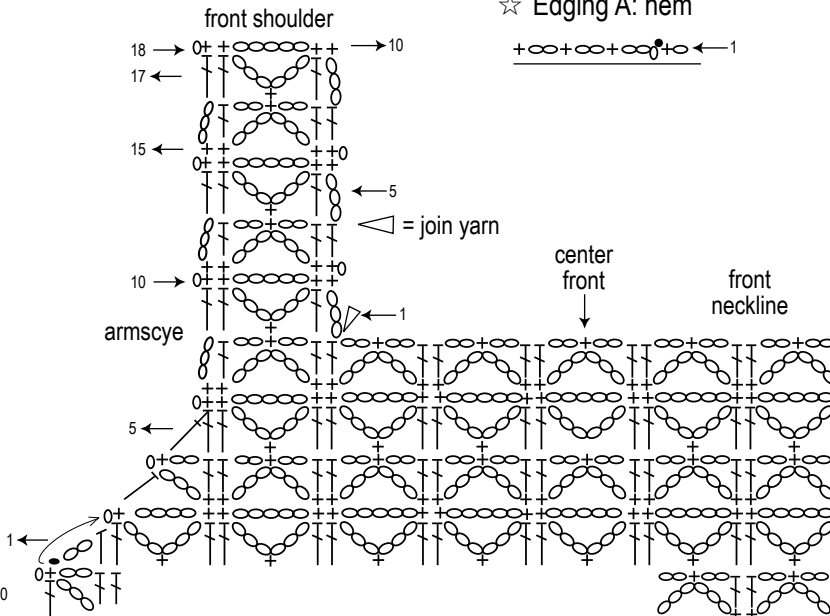
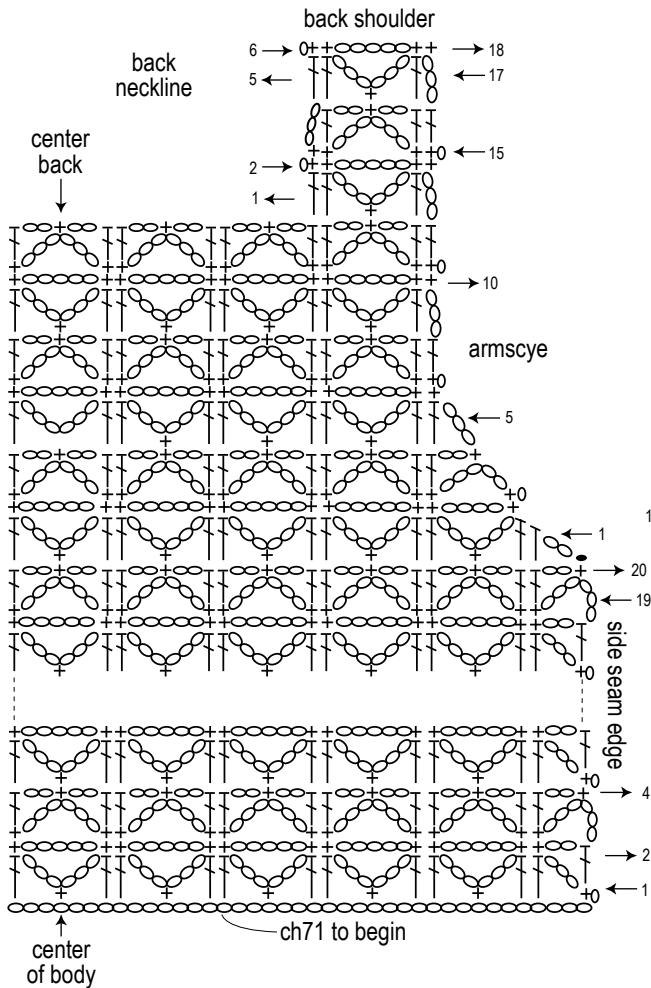


Hem, armhole, and neckline edging

5.0mm hook



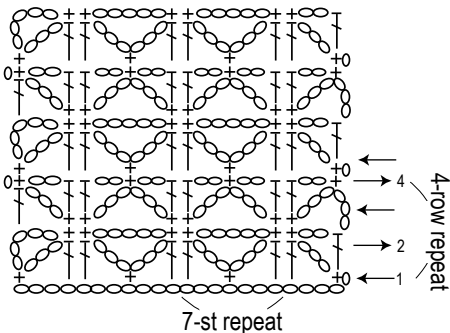
★ Edging B:
