677AW Chameleon Camera Stranded Armwarmers



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Chameleon Camera Print [75% wool, 25% nylon; 459 yds/420m per 3.53oz/100g skein]; color #03 leaf, 1 skein [35g]
- Pierrot Yarns Chameleon Camera Solid [75% wool, 25% nylon; 459 yds/420m per 3.53oz/100g skein]; color #101 off-white, 1 skein [15g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- palm circumference 21cm/8.27"
- length 26.5cm/10.43"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch (stranded knitting): 28 sts and 29 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method with 2.7mm needles. Work in k2p2 ribbing. Change to 3.0mm needles, then work in pattern stitches A, B, and C as indicated. Change to k2p2 ribbing and 2.7mm needles when indicated. Bind off in pattern. Knit second armwarmer identical to the first. Seam each armwarmer with mattress stitch, leaving an opening in each for thumb.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit stitch

p = purl stitch
