214a-05 Raglan Sleeve Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto 2/Pure Wool [100% wool; 79yds/72m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #2 ivory, 9 skeins [355g]
- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso/Pure Wool Fingering [100% wool; 164yds/150m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #326 green, 2 skeins [75g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- center back neck-to-cuff 77.5cm/30.51"
- back length 55.5cm/21.85"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 18 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch: 17 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in stockinette stitch, working decreases in first row of stockinette stitch. Shape raglan seam edges by binding off stitches as indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (2 sts in from the edge).


Front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in pattern stitch, working decreases in first row of pattern stitch. Shape raglan seam edges in the same manner as back and sleeves.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges of body and sleeves together with mattress stitch. Seam sides of body and sleeve undersides with one continuous mattress stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
