# 214a-04 High Neck Pullover



### Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% merino; 103yds/94m per 1.06oz/30g skein]; color #203 deep blue, 9 skeins [260g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.5mm (US 7) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- zipper (18cm/7.09" long)

### Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- center back neck-to-cuff 24.5cm/9.65"
- back length 56cm/22.05"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• k1p2 ribbing: 25 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### Summary

Body (make 2 of the same): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p2 ribbing. Work increases at each edge using lifted increase. Work fully fashioned decreases 3 stitches in from the edge. Place markers for sleeve. Rather than bind off, place all stitches on stitch holder.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders and sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches from front and back neckline area; work collar in k2p1 ribbing. (When the collar is folded down, it will appear as k1p2 ribbing.) Bind off loosely in pattern. Sew zipper to collar slit.

BO = bind off	CO = cast on	k = knit	p = purl	PU = pick up	RE = row(s) even	#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
