

# 214a-08 Motif Sweater



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Teori Wool [100% wool; 547yds/500m per 3.53oz/100g cone]; color #2 ivory, 2 cones [200g]
- Pierrot Yarns Kirara [89% other, 11% polyester; 1892yds/1730m per 1.76oz/50g cone]; color #08 gold, 1 cone [35g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 35.5cm/13.98"
- back length 49.5cm/19.49"
- sleeve length 45.5cm/17.91"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 37 rows
- motif A: 9cm/3.54" x 9.5cm/3.74"

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

✿**Note 1:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

✿**Note 2:** Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Teori Wool and 1 strand of Kirara).

**Back & front body:** To begin motifs A, B, C, and D, work chain and join into the round. Work motifs A and C in the round. Work motifs B and D back and forth in rows. Work in order from motif 1 to motif 63, joining them together on the last round using slip stitch.


**Sleeves:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in stockinette stitch. Bind off. Seam sides of sleeves (undersides) with mattress stitch.

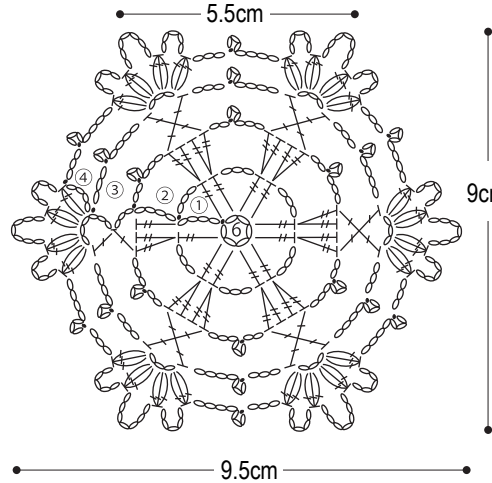
**Finishing:** Seam sleeves to body with right sides facing each other using chain seam (alternating ch st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Align ◇ on sleeve to ◇ on body; seam with chain seam.

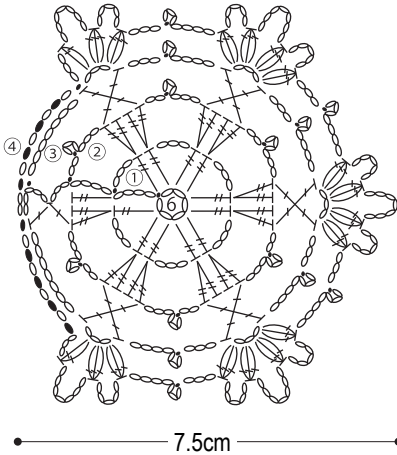
BO = bind off      ch = chain      CO = cast on      dc = double crochet (US)      RE = row(s) even      #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

**\*Note:** all motifs are worked with 2.3mm hook.

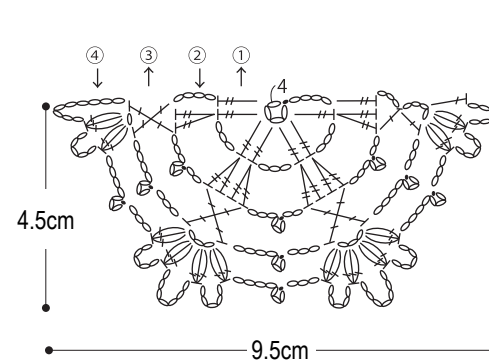

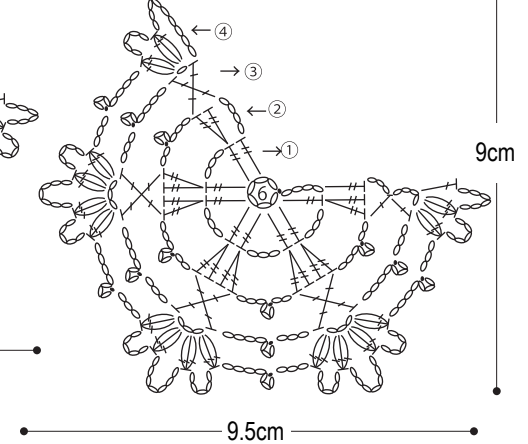
**Motif C =**   
(make 8)



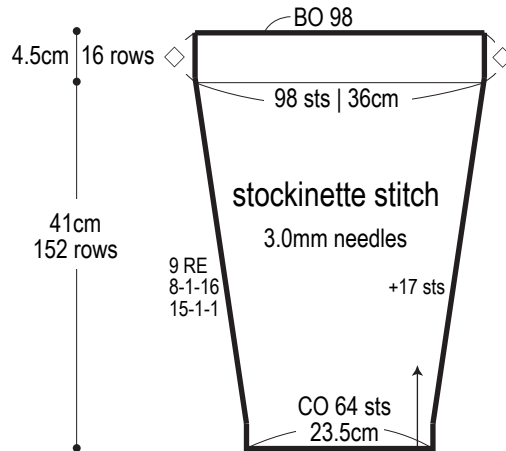
**Motif B =**    
(make 9)



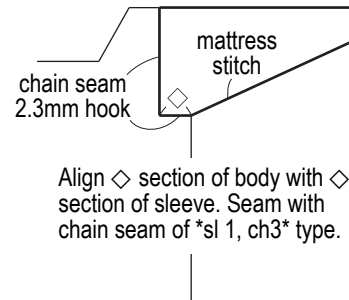

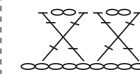

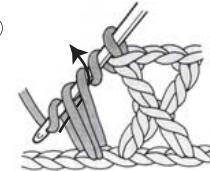


## dc cross stitch



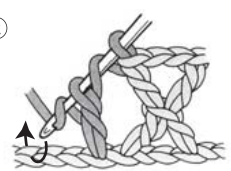
When there are 3 ch sts in dc cross stitch, use these dc cross st instructions as a reference.

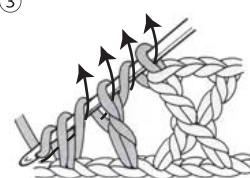
Wrap yarn around hook twice; insert hook into chain; pull up a loop. Wrap yarn around hook once; draw through 2 loops on hook.

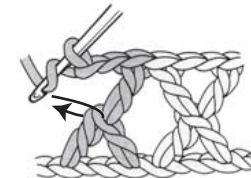


Wrap yarn around hook. Insert hook into 3rd st of chain. Pull up a loop; wrap yarn around hook once; draw through 2 loops on hook.

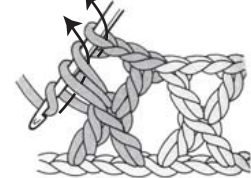

Wrap yarn around hook again, then draw through 2 loops on hook. Repeat 2 more times.



Ch2, wrap yarn around hook, insert hook into sts indicated by arrow, and pull up a loop (3 loops remaining on hook).

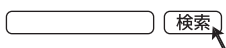


Wrap yarn around hook again, then draw through 2 loops on hook. Repeat once more.

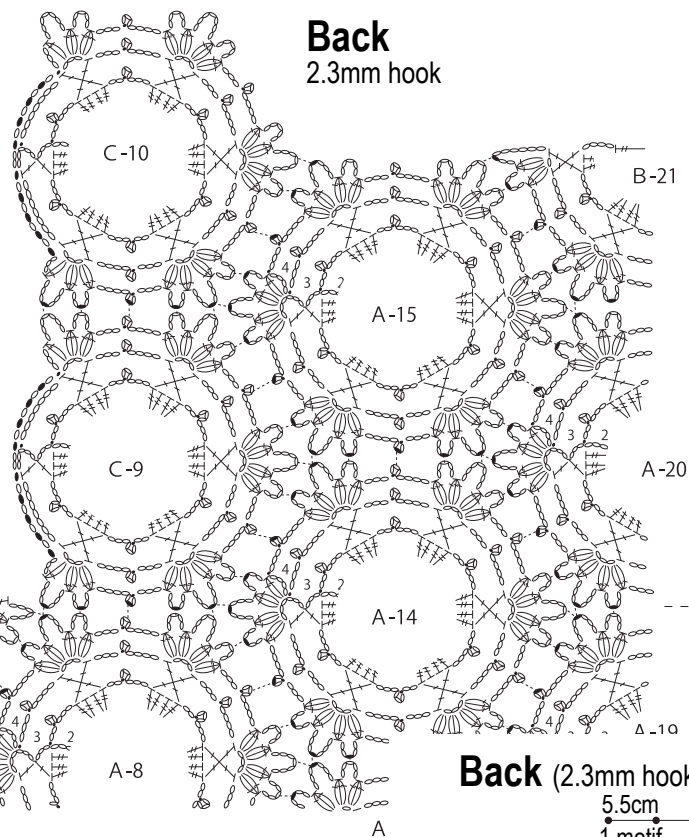

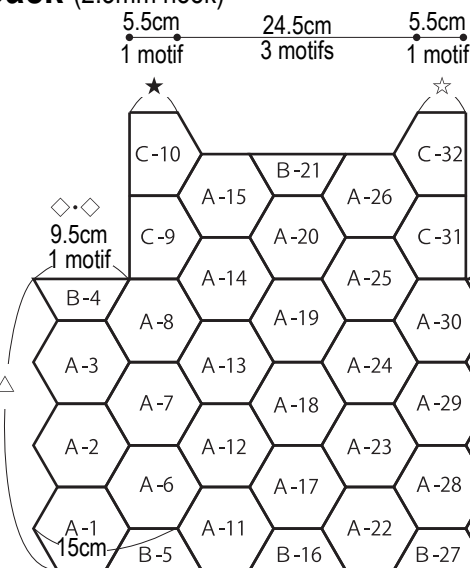
## Back 2.3mm hook



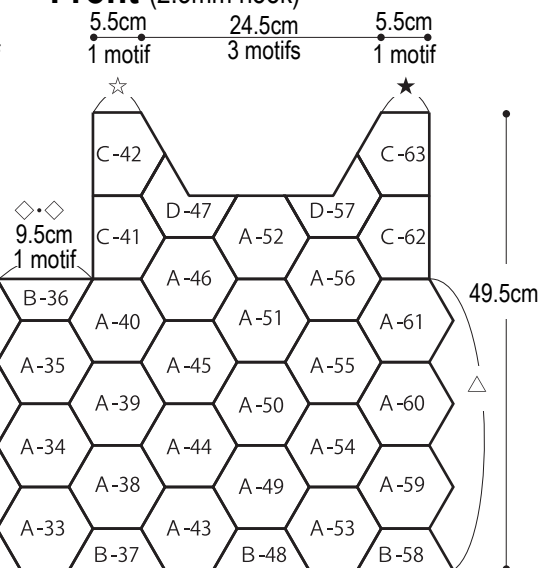
## Front 2.3mm hook
