# 25-8 Simple Vest



#### Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Cord Cotton [100% cotton; 77 yds/70m per 1.41oz/100g hank]; color #9, 4 hanks [380q]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) and 8.0mm (US 11) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.6mm (approx. US 101/2) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge

#### Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 57cm/22.44"

### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

· stockinette stitch: 11 sts and 19 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

## Summary

**Body:** Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch. Shape sides by working decreases/ increases (see schematic) 5 stitches in from the edge. Shape armscye by binding off stitches as indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases 6 stitches in from the edges. Work the 6 stitches at the edges of each armhole in k1p1 ribbing. Shape neckline by binding off stitches as indicated and by working decreases at edges. Remove provisional cast-on edge from hem, picking up the live stitches as you go. Work hem in pattern stitch, then bind off.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in pattern stitch, then bind off. For hem and neckline edging, allow fabric to roll naturally.

#### Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

k = knit


p = purl

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
