

214a-24 Dolman Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Jewel [55% polyester, 45% wool; 109yds/100m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
 - small (110cm size): color #02 powdery rose, 3 skeins [115g]
 - large (120cm size): color #02 powdery rose, 4 skeins [125g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) and 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.5mm (US 7) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

Japanese children's clothing sizes are based on the child's height in centimeters. 110cm size (43.3") and 120cm size (47.2") correspond roughly to US children's sizes 4 and 6.

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in stockinette stitch. Shape raglan seam by working fully fashioned decreases (2 sts in from the edge).


Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in pattern stitch. Shape sleeve sides with lifted increases, then shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (2 sts in from the edge).

Finishing: Seam sides, sleeve undersides, and raglan edges with mattress stitch. Seam underarm gusset with Kitchener stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.






