

214w-01 Mannish Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cannes [100% alpaca; 131yds/120m per 1.76oz/50g skein]; color #05 smart green, 15 skeins [725g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (21mm/0.83")
- 2 snaps (12mm/0.47")

Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- cross back width 37cm/14.57"
- back length 58cm/22.83"
- sleeve length 57.5cm/22.64"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 16 sts and 22 rows
- twisted rib stitch: 18 sts and 22 rows
- pattern stitch: 16 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in twisted k1p1 ribbing, pattern stitch, and stockinette stitch as indicated. Work front placket in twisted k1p1 ribbing at the same time as you work the front body pieces, working buttonholes in right front only.. Then continue from placket to back collar section. Reverse shaping of right front for left front.

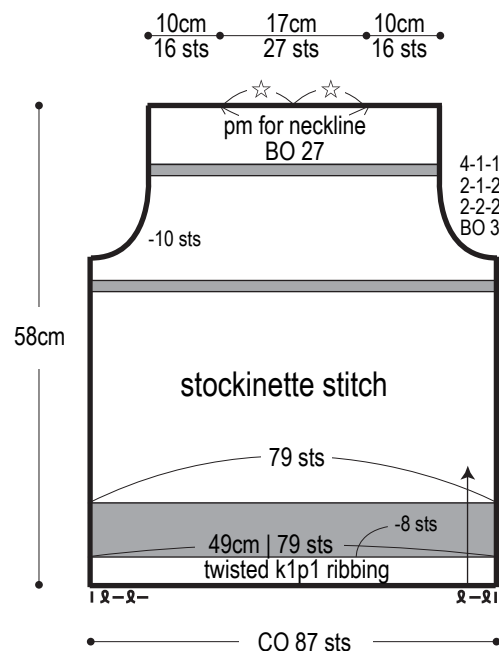
Pockets: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in twisted k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch as indicated. Bind off in pattern. Seam to front body as indicated in finishing schematic.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam bound-off ends of back collar pieces (the ones that continue from the front plackets) and seam with crochet slip stitch seam with wrong sides facing. Seam long edges of back collar pieces to neckline with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Fasten snaps and buttons to body.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on OH = on hold (place on stitch holder) pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even ### = rows-stitches-times

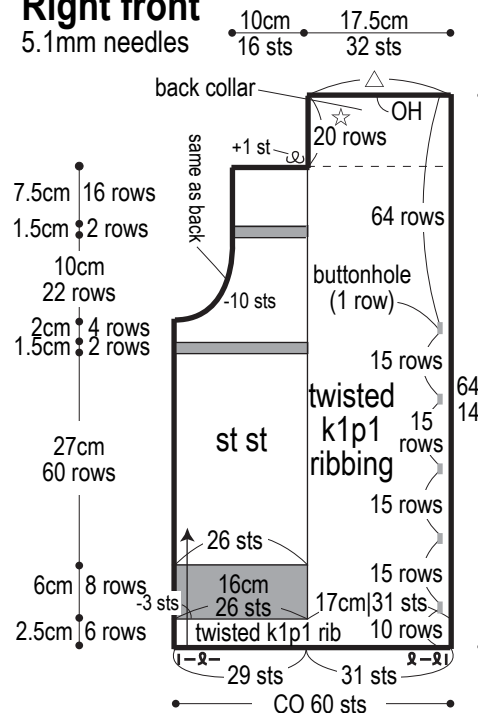

■ = pattern stitch

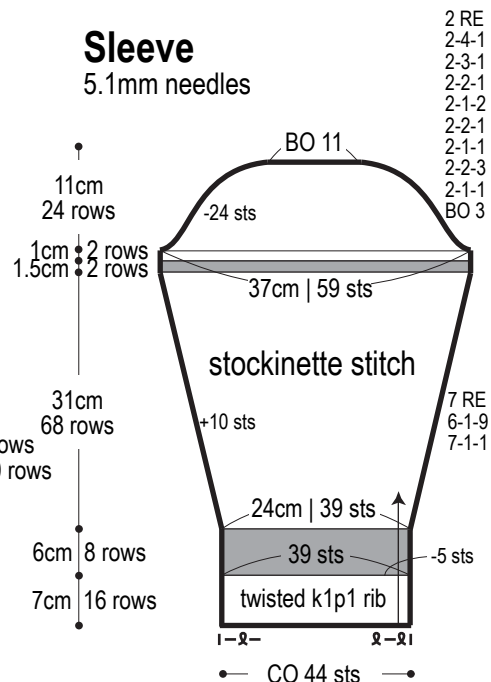
⌚ = backwards loop cast-on increase

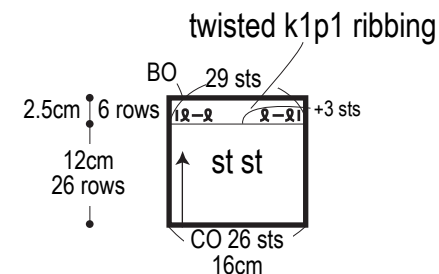


*Reverse shaping for left front, omitting buttonholes.

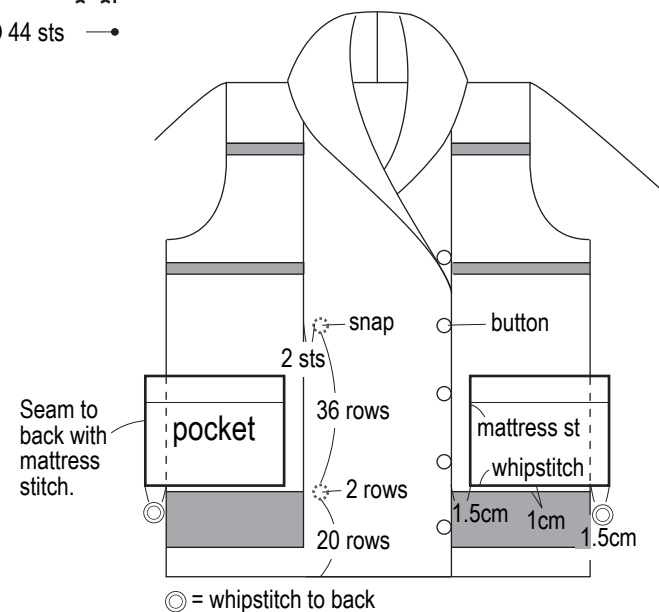

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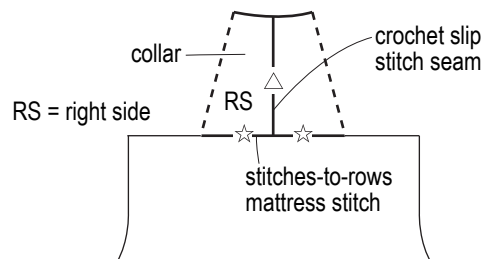


Finishing

Back collar



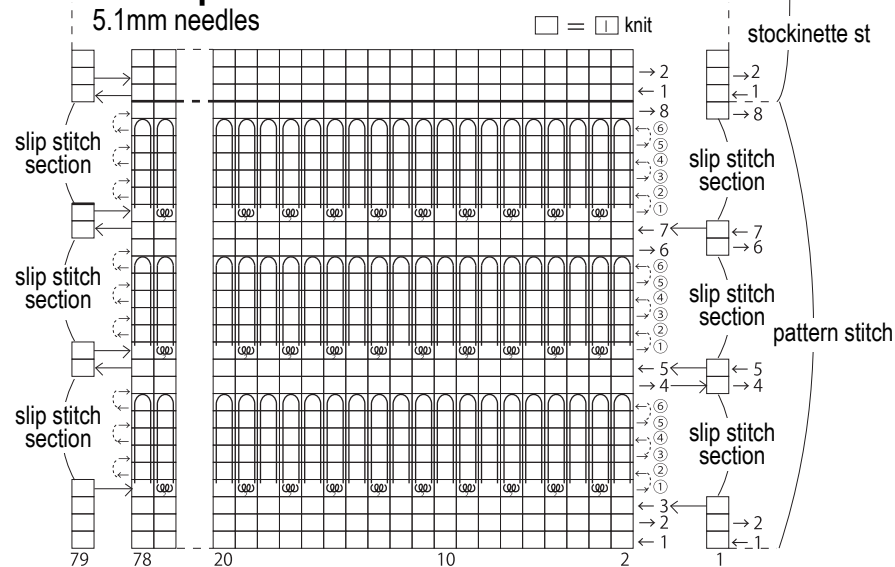
※Because the collar will be folded down, seam from the inside.

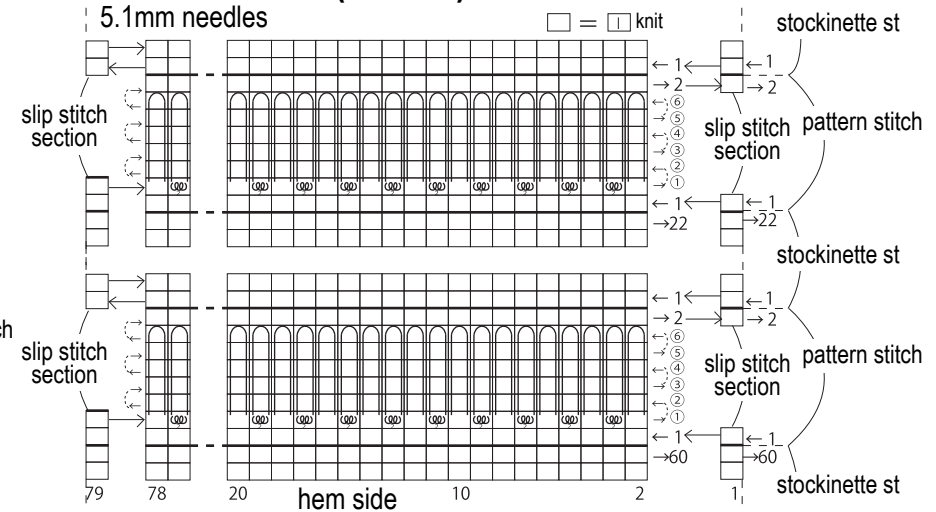
Back: pattern stitch



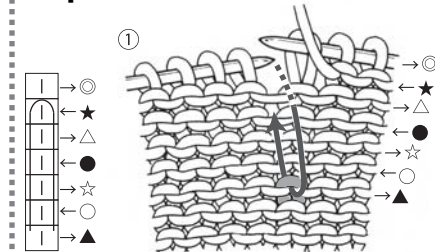
⊗ = ⊗ = drop st (wrap 2 times)

*Right edge: from ① to ⑥, slip 1 st without knitting.
Left edge: from ② to ⑥, slip 1 st without knitting.

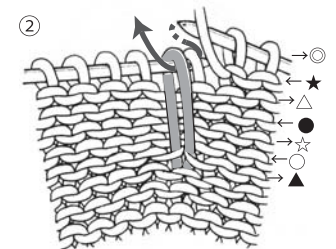
Pattern stitch (2 rows)



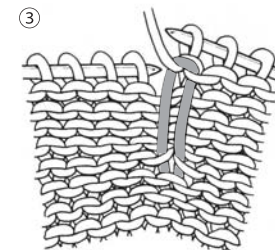
Slip stitch brioche



Working symbols in order, temporarily slip the st on ⊙ row to the right needle without knitting. Insert the left needle into the st on ▲ row in the direction the arrow points.



Return the st slipped onto the right needle to the left needle. Work together with the stitch slipped from several rows beneath in step ①.



One completed slip stitch brioche pattern repeat.

Right front: twisted k1p1 rib, pattern st, & buttonholes
