

214w-08 Round Cut Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso/Pure Wool Fingering [50% merino, 50% wool; 164yds/150m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
 - color #301 off-white, 2 skeins [45g]
 - color #305 pink, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #324 sunflower, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #307 crimson, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #314 cyan green, 1 skein [25g]
 - color #319 chestnut brown, 1 skein [35g]
 - color #329 deep gray, 1 skein [35g]
 - color #321 gray beige, 2 skeins [45g]
 - color #322 French gray, 3 skeins [100g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 34.5cm/13.58"
- back length 52.5cm/20.67"
- sleeve length 52.5cm/20.67"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (stranded): 30 sts and 33 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch (stranded knitting). For front piece, start at left hem, place stitches on stitch holder after row 25, then start right hem. On row 26 of right hem, work stitches into crochet chain (worked in advance for this purpose), then continue to left hem. Continue knitting front as one piece.

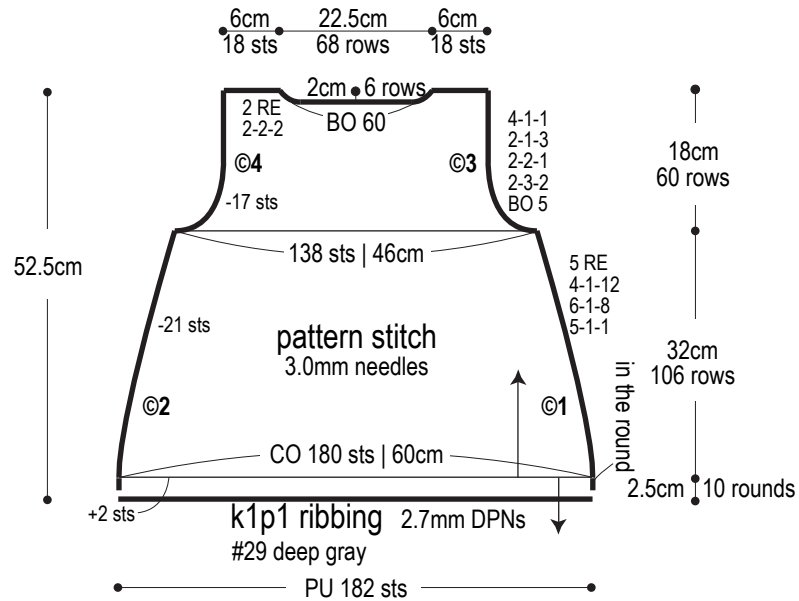
Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch (stranded knitting).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches along hem; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Pick up stitches along neckline; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern as for hem. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

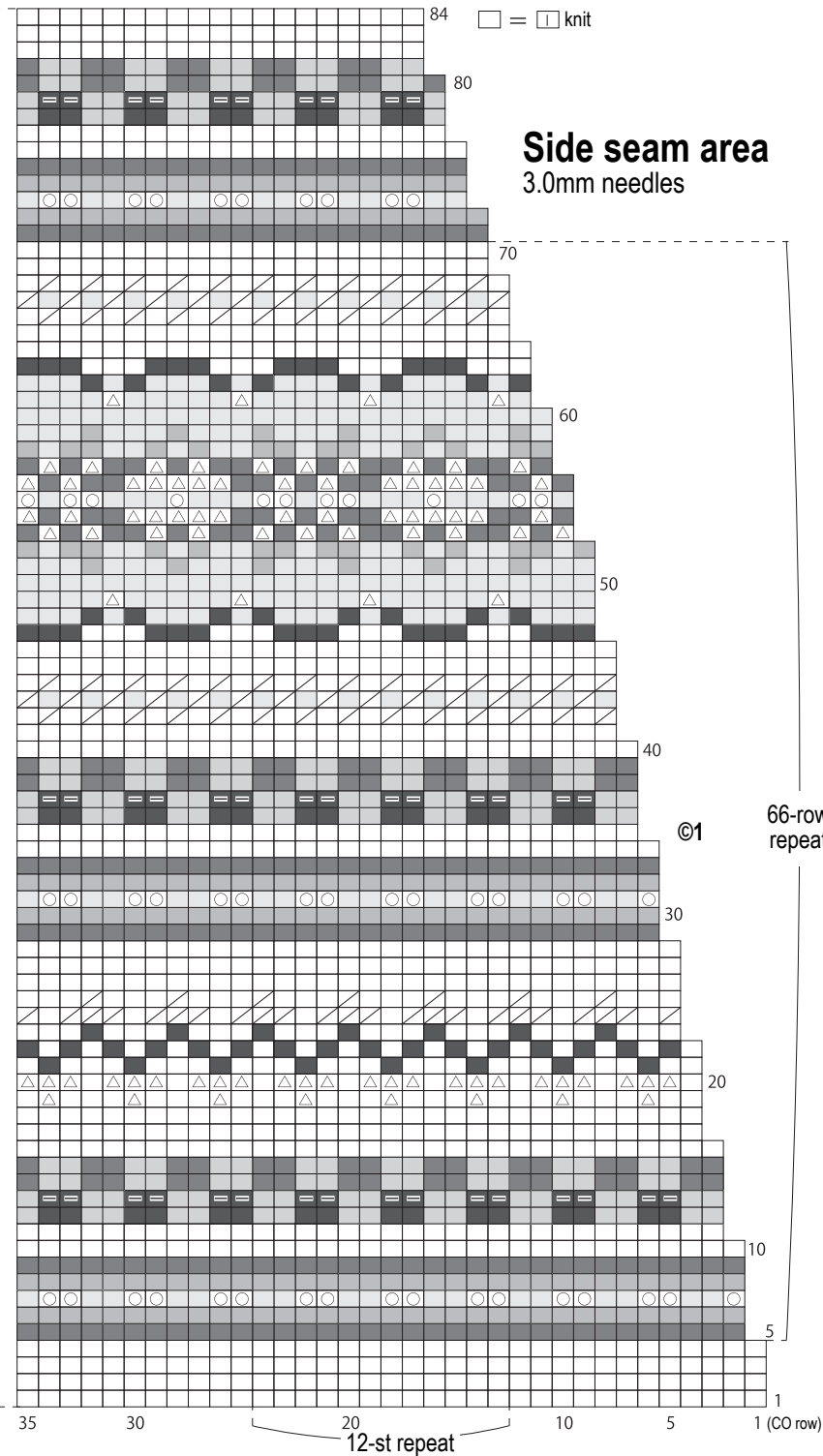
