

25-26-23 Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nep Tweed Old [85% acrylic, 10% wool, 5% polyester; 55 yds/50m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #10 dark steel gray, 14 skeins [560g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles (straight & circular) or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- chest 110cm/43.31"
- cross back width 48cm/18.90"
- back length 66cm/25.98"
- sleeve length 54cm/21.26"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 13 sts and 19rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. For collar, pick up stitches around front and back neckline, then work in stockinette stitch. Bind off from wrong side. Seam sleeves to body with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides in one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side).


Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- PU = pick up
- RE = row(s) even
- #/# = rows-stitches-times


Back
