98-99-17 Polo Sweater



Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2/Pure Wool [100% wool; 79yds/72m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #130, 15 skeins [570g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6), 4.2mm (approx. US 6), and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 4 buttons (18mm/0.71")

Finished measurements:

- bust 100cm/39.37"
- · cross back width 39cm/15.35"
- back length 57cm/22.44"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

· pattern stitch: 21 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body & sleeves: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch according to schematics and chart. For front neckline, place the 9 stitches at center where the placket will be on a stitch holder. Remove provisional cast-on edge from hem and cuffs (picking up the live stitches as you go); work edging in k1p1 ribbing.

Collar: First pick up and knit stitches along front neckline placket, working buttonholes in right side only. Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Pick up stitches from front neckline placket center (on stitch holder) and work collar in k1p1 ribbing. At both edges of collar, k3.

Finishing: Seam sides of body and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on









Front neckline placket: k1p1 ribbing
